

Keep Moving Forward

Genesis 12:1 (ESV) “Go from your country...to the land that I will show you.”

Exodus 14:15 (ESV) “Tell the people of Israel to **go forward**.”

Job 17:9 (NLT) The righteous **keep moving forward**...

Deuteronomy 1:6–7 (NIV) “You have stayed long enough at this mountain. Break camp and advance...” Break camp and **move on**, break camp and **move forward**.

Philippians 3:12–15 (NASB) ¹²Not that I have already obtained *it* or have already become perfect, but I press on so that I may lay hold of that for which also I was laid hold of by Christ Jesus.

1. Develop a Forward Mindset and Posture

¹²Not that I have already obtained *it* or have already become perfect, but I press on so that I may lay hold of that for which also I was laid hold of by Christ Jesus...

Press on: continue to pursue, continue to run after

Reaching forward: to lean in, to strain towards

Luke 9:62 (NLT) But Jesus told him, “Anyone who puts a hand to the plow and then looks back is not fit for the Kingdom of God.”

2. Maintain a Forward Focus.
