THE PATH TO THE BLESSED LIFE

1. WE ARE BLESSED WHEN WE MAKE GOD OUR LORD.

Psalm 33:12 (NIV) Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD, the people he chose for his inheritance.

Blessed: happy, prosperous, enlarged, having divine favor; empowered to prosper and succeed (in every area of life)

Psalm 144:15 (NIV) Blessed is the people whose God is the LORD.

Luke 6:46–49 (NLT) ⁴⁶“So why do you keep calling me ‘Lord, Lord!’ when you don’t do what I say? ⁴⁷I will show you what it’s like when someone comes to me, listens to my teaching, and then follows it. ⁴⁸It is like a person building a house who digs deep and lays the foundation on solid rock. When the floodwaters rise and break against that house, it stands firm because it is well built. ⁴⁹But anyone who hears and doesn’t obey is like a person who builds a house right on the ground, without a foundation. When the floods sweep down against that house, it will collapse into a heap of ruins.”

2. THERE'S ONLY ONE PATH TO THE BLESSED LIFE.

Psalm 1:1–3 (NASB) 1 How blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked, nor stand in the path of sinners, nor sit in the seat of scoffers! 2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and in His law he meditates day and night. 3 He will be like a tree *firmly* planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in its season and its leaf does not wither; and in **whatever he does, he prospers.**

Psalm 1:4–6 (NLT) ⁴ But not the wicked! They are like worthless chaff, scattered by the wind. ⁵ They will be condemned at the time of judgment. Sinners will have no place among the godly. ⁶ For the LORD watches over the path of the godly, but the path of the wicked leads to destruction.

Matthew 7:13–14 (NIV) ¹³ “Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. ¹⁴ But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it.”

Psalm 119:24 (NIV) Your statutes are my delight; they are my counselors.

Psalm 119:128 (ESV) Therefore, I consider all your precepts to be right; I hate every false way.
