### **Conversation Starters**

- What was family life like before COVID-19?
- What is family life like right now?

#### **Discuss**

No matter what your situation (good or bad) might be like, COVID-19 has probably got you thinking about your family and family life like never before – rethinking, reimagining, revisioning. One thing that could make the most difference in family life now and for the future is vision, and when the Bible talks about vision, the idea is to have God's vision.

"Where there is no vision, the people perish." (Proverbs 29:18 KJV)

Example: Jim & Susan's Family Vision:

- Peaceful home
- Learning as a lifestyle
- Christ in the family

- Marked by serving
- Character
- Mutual Respect
- What is your vision for your family now or in the future?
- Is it clear enough to really work like a target on the wall?
- How are you expanding that vision as you grow older?

Once you have vision, you have to then let the vision inform the choices you make about family life and activity and budget, etc. For example, because Jim and Susan had learning as a lifestyle in their vision, they homeschooled their kids.

- What purposeful, conscious choices can be made now to work towards fulfilling your vision?
- Do your choices require you to make any sacrifices?

The heart of a family is marriage. Your family will never be stronger than the marriage. As you grow older in age, there's also an opportunity to grow deeper in love that shouldn't be missed and will continually shape your family.

- Whether single or already married, do you have a vision for marriage?
- How can you keep romance alive and growing?
