# Discuss

Today's culture has so many opportunities for customization. Whether it is your favorite coffee, food, travel, and so forth, you can usually create your own experience. Some try to take the same approach with spirituality, however, Christianity doesn't allow for that. While there may be some truth in other religions, Christianity says that there is only one way to God – and that's through Christ.

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. (John 14:6 NIV)

The Bible teaches that everyone, regardless of how "good" of a person you are, has a need to be made right in relationship with God. It isn't God's desire to see anyone lost and apart from Him, but He gives us the freedom to choose or reject the offer of a relationship. The freedom ensures that the relationship is authentic and real rather than being forced on us.

For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. (<u>Romans 3:23 NLT</u>)

"Very truly I [Jesus] tell you, whoever hears my word and believes him [God] who sent me has eternal life and will not be judged but has crossed over from death to life." (John 5:24 NIV)

- If someone followed your every thought or move, what would they find out about you?
- How would it feel to have everything wrong you've ever done forgiven without consequence?
- What would a relationship with God look like if it was forced on us?

While the presence of hell is disturbing, it's existence is necessary because it shows us that there is morality and a true right and wrong and a God who brings justice. The equally significant truth is that the God of the Bible is loving. We can trust that He will do the right and just thing by every person. We can trust His character. He sent Jesus to the world to offer us amazing grace along with His truth.

For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. (<u>Romans</u> <u>6:23 NIV</u>)
