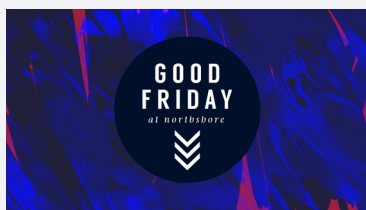

Apr. 1 at 8, 9:30, 11am, and 12:30pm

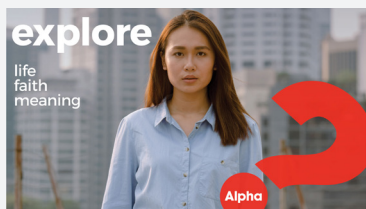
Bring your family and friends to discover the hope of Easter and share on social media. There will be kids programming available at all services.

Roxanne McMillan's earliest memories are wrought with trauma, violence, and excruciating heartache. She remembers herself and her siblings being severely abused, often by other members of the family. Being the oldest in her family, Roxanne McMillan recalls corralling her siblings together to keep them safe during family gatherings at her grandmother's house when the adults drank heavily among them and fighting was inevitable.

Growing up in an incredibly abusive family environment filled Roxanne with anxiety and depression. Her anxiety manifested itself physically, and seven-year-old Roxanne was put on tranquilizers, though she often spat them out...
