Understanding Obedience

Exodus 7:1-6

And the LORD said to Moses, "See, I have made you like God to Pharaoh, and your brother Aaron shall be your prophet. ² You shall speak all that I command you, and your brother Aaron shall tell Pharaoh to let the people of Israel go out of his land. ³ But I will harden Pharaoh's heart, and though I multiply my signs and wonders in the land of Egypt,

Exodus 7:1-6

⁴ Pharaoh will not listen to you. Then I will lay my hand on Egypt and bring my hosts, my people the children of Israel, out of the land of Egypt by great acts of judgment. ⁵ The Egyptians shall know that I am the LORD, when I stretch out my hand against Egypt and bring out the people of Israel from among them." 6 Moses and Aaron did so; they did just as the LORD commanded them.

Exodus 8:16-19

Then the LORD said to Moses, "Say to Aaron, 'Stretch out your staff and strike the dust of the earth, so that it may become gnats in all the land of Egypt." 17 And they did so. Aaron stretched out his hand with his staff and struck the dust of the earth, and there were gnats on man and beast. All the dust of the earth became gnats in all the land of Egypt.

Moses' Pattern of Obedience

- God invites Moses to join Him in what He was doing to deliver Israel.
- God told Moses what he was to do.
- Moses obeyed.
- God accomplished what He purposed to do.
- Moses and those around him came to know God more clearly and intimately.

Pattern of Obedience

- God invites you to join Him in what He's doing.
- God has directed and made promises to you.
- You obey.
- God accomplishes what He purposed to do.
- You, and those around you, come to know God more clearly and intimately.

There's a process to obedience.



1. Search (the Bible) and ask to God to reveal Histruth to you. (Pray Psalm 119:33-35)

Psalm 119:33-35

- Teach me, O LORD, the way of your statutes; and I will keep it to the end.
- ³⁴ Give me understanding, that I may keep your law and observe it with my whole heart.
- Lead me in the path of your commandments, for I delight in it.
