


O Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! You have set your glory above the heavens.


Yet you have made him [man] a little lower than the heavenly beings and crowned him with glory and honor.

Romans 1:21-23

For although they knew God, they did not honor him as God or give thanks to him, but they became futile in their thinking, and their foolish hearts were darkened. Claiming to be wise, they became fools, and they exchanged the glory of the immortal God for the images resembling mortal man and birds and animals and creeping things.

Romans 3:22-25

For there is no distinction: for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, who God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith.

Great Exchange #1:

Humans trade God given and God intended glory for lesser things. This is the sin of falling short of God's glory.



Great Exchange #2:

Jesus trades his glorious position and privilege for a human body; then he willingly trades his life for ours to restore our ability to glorify God.

What should be *under* you but has been given unto
glory and is *above* you (e.g. work, stuff,
#couplegoals, #familygoals, entertainment hobbies,
etc.)?

Romans 8:16-21

The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, provided we suffer with him in order that we may also be glorified with him.

Romans 8:16-21

For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory that is to be revealed to us. For the creation waits with eager longing for the revealing of the sons of God.

Romans 8:16-21

For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of him who subjected it, in hope that the creation itself will be set free from its bondage to corruption and obtain the freedom of the glory of the children of God.

Discipleship Cues
