

2 After two days he will revive us;on the third day he will raise us up,


that we may live before him.



DISCIPLESHIP CUES UPROOTING & HEART OF SIN

1) Ask yourself at the end of the day, "Lord, when did I sin against you today?" Write down what comes to mind.

2) Ask a close friend, your spouse, or your parent: "In what ways have you seen even a hint of sin in me?" Don't defend or justify. Just listen.

DISCIPLESHIP CUES UPROOTING A HEART OF SIN

3) When you recognize sin, confess it as soon as you can and as deeply as you can. (Use the 7 A's of confession)

- 1. Address everyone involved (All those whom you affected)
- 2. Avoid if, but, and maybe (Do not try to excuse your wrongs)
- 3. <u>Admit specifically</u> (Both attitudes and actions)
- 4. <u>Acknowledge the hurt</u> (Express sorrow for hurting someone)
- 5. <u>Accept the consequences</u> (Such as making restitution)
- 6. <u>Alter your behavior</u> (Change your attitudes and actions)
- 7. Ask for forgiveness (Always last, Don't rush/skip 1-6 to get here)

DISCIPLESHIP CUES UPROOTING A HEART OF SIN
