• And from that hour the disciple took her to his own house







for his clothing (Psalm 22:18) "I thirst" (Psalm 69:21) • Family watched him die (Psa 38:11) · His body would be pierced (Zech 12:10) • Not a bone would be broken (Psa 34:20) Last words "It is finished" (Psa 22:31) • Buried in the tomb of a rich man (Isa 53:8-9)
