(1) **message of wisdom.** Properly explaining doctrinal truth. Example- What God has revealed about Jesus' death on the cross.

GIFTS OF 1 CORINTHIANS 12

(2) **message of knowledge.** Providing the proper theological rationale for decisions concerning Christian living (based on doctrinal truth).
