

Shaking Thrones, Kings and Kingdoms
The 8 Prophetic Seasons Of The Prophet Elijah. Feb. 25, 2024

Key verse(s): 2 Kings 2:1, 9 V 1 When the Lord was about to take Elijah up to heaven in a whirlwind, Elijah and Elisha were on their way from Gilgal.
V 9 Tell me, what can I do for you before I am taken from you? Let me inherit a double portion of your spirit, Elisha replied.

1. A Nation Under Demonic Oppression (God Expose Ungodly Foundations!)

1 Kings 16:32-33 V 32 He (Ahab) set up an altar for Baal in the temple of Baal that he built in Samaria. V 33 Ahab ...did more to provoke the Lord, the God of Israel, to anger than all the kings of Israel before him.

2. The Drought Over The Nation (We Are Being Sifted and Shaken!)

1 Kings 17:1 Elijah..., said, as the Lord, the God of Israel, lives, whom I serve, there will be neither dew nor rain in the next few years except at my word.

3. Elijah Fed By Ravens (God Give Us Hidden Provision!)

1 Kings 17:6 V 6 The ravens brought him bread and meat in the morning and bread and meat in the evening, and he drank from the brook.

4. The Widow At Zarephath (God Provide In Unusual Ways!)

1 Kings 17:10-12 V 10 So he went to Zarephath. When he came to the town gate, a widow was there gathering sticks. He called to her and asked, Would you bring me a little water in a jar so that I may have something to drink?
V 11 As she was going to get it, he called, And bring me, please, a piece of bread. V 12 As surely as the Lord your God lives, she replied, I don't have any bread – only a handful of flour in a jar and a little oil in a jug. I am gathering a few sticks to take home and make a meal for myself and my so, that we may eat it – and die.

• Supernatural Provision (We Step Out In Faith, To Bless Others!)

1 Kings 17:15-16 V 15 She went away and did as Elijah had told her. So there was food every day for Elijah and for the woman and her family.
V 16 For the jar of flour was not used up and the jug of oil did not run dry, in keeping with the word of the Lord spoken by Elijah.

- **Signs, Wonders, Miracles Season (God We Need The Holy Spirit!)**

1 Kings 17:21-22 V 21 The he stretched himself out on the boy three times and cried to the Lord, O Lord my God, let this boy's life return to him!

V 22 The Lord heard Elijah's cry, and the boys life returned to him, and he lived.

5. Get Ready For Rain, Season (God Give Us Heavy Rain!)

1 Kings 18:1-15 V 1 After a long time, in the third year, the word of the Lord came to Elijah: Go and present yourself to Ahab, and I will send rain on the land. V 41 Go, eat and drink, for there is the sound of a heavy rain.

6. Mount Horeb (Raise Up New Leaders, Grow The Church Remnant!)

1 Kings 19:15-16 Hazael king of Aram, Jehu king of Israel, Elisha, the prophet V 18 ...seven thousand in Israel – all whose knees have not bowed to Baal...

7. The Call Of Elisha Season (Give Us New Righteous Leaders!)

Kings 19:19-21 V 19 So Elijah went up from there and found Elisha son of Shephat. He was plowing with twelve yoke of oxen, and he himself was driving the twelfth pair. Elijah went up to him and threw his cloak around him. V 20 Elisha then left his oxen and an after Elijah. "Let me kiss my father and mother good-by, he said, and then I will come with you. Go back, Elijah replied. What have I done to you? V 21 So Elisha left him and went back. He took his yoke of oxen and slaughtered them. He burned up the plowing equipment to cook the meat and gave it to the people, and they ate. Then he set out to follow Elijah and became his attendant.

8. Elijah's Transition To Heaven (God Give Us A Turnaround Mantle!)

2 Kings 2:1, 9, 11, 13 V 1 When the Lord was about to take Elijah up to heaven in a whirlwind, Elijah and Elisha were on their way from Gilgal.

V 9 Tell me, what can I do for you before I am taken from you? Let me inherit a double portion of your spirit, Elisha replied.

V 11 As they were walking along and talking together, suddenly a chariot of fire and horses of fire appeared and separated the two of them, and Elijah went up to heaven in a whirlwind...

V 13 He picked up the cloak that had fallen from Elijah and went back and stood on the bank of the Jordan.
