## Exiting Egypt – Message 6 – Doubts, Declaration, Demonstration

**Exodus 5:22-23 (NKJV)** <sup>22</sup> So Moses returned to the LORD and said, "Lord, why have You brought trouble on this people? Why is it You have sent me? <sup>23</sup> For since I came to Pharaoh to speak in Your name, he has done evil to this people; neither have You delivered Your people at all."

Exodus 6:1-9 (NKJV) <sup>1</sup> Then the LORD said to Moses, "Now you shall see what I will do to Pharaoh. For with a strong hand he will let them go, and with a strong hand he will drive them out of his land." <sup>2</sup> And God spoke to Moses and said to him: "I am the LORD. <sup>3</sup> I appeared to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, as God Almighty, but by My name LORD I was not known to them. <sup>4</sup> I have also established My covenant with them, to give them the land of Canaan, the land of their pilgrimage, in which they were strangers. <sup>5</sup> And I have also heard the groaning of the children of Israel whom the Egyptians keep in bondage, and I have remembered My covenant. <sup>6</sup> Therefore say to the children of Israel: 'I am the LORD; I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, I will rescue you from their bondage, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments. <sup>7</sup> I will take you as My people, and I will be your God. Then you shall know that I am the LORD your God who brings you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians. <sup>8</sup> And I will bring you into the land which I swore to give to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; and I will give it to you as a heritage: I am the LORD.' " <sup>9</sup> So Moses spoke thus to the children of Israel; but they did not heed Moses, because of anguish of spirit and cruel bondage.

- I. KNOW: Doubts
  - A. We Doubt because we forget who is God
  - B. We Doubt because we forget the goodness of God
  - C. We Doubt because we forget the purpose of God
- II. GROW: Declaration
  - A. Get to Know God by His Word
- **2 Peter 3:9** The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.
- **1 Peter 3:20** who formerly were disobedient, when once the Divine longsuffering waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight souls, were saved through water.

**Exodus 6:2-3 (NKJV)** And God spoke to Moses and said to him: "I am the LORD. <sup>3</sup> I appeared to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, as God Almighty, but by My name LORD I was not known to them.

- B. Get to Know God by His Names
- C. Get to Know God by Experience

**Exodus 6:6-8 (NKJV)** Therefore say to the children of Israel: 'I am the LORD; I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, I will rescue you from their bondage, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments. <sup>7</sup> I will take you as My people, and I will be your God. Then you shall know that I am the LORD your God who brings you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians. <sup>8</sup> And I will bring you into the land which I swore to give to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; and I will give it to you as a heritage: I am the LORD.'" III. SHOW: Demonstration

- A. It is in the trials that you need Yahweh
- B. It is in the trials that you see Yahweh

**Isaiah 45:5-7 (NKJV)** I am the LORD, and there is no other; There is no God besides Me. I will gird you, though you have not known Me, <sup>6</sup> That they may know from the rising of the sun to its setting That there is none besides Me. I am the LORD, and there is no other; <sup>7</sup> I form the light and create darkness, I make peace and create calamity; I, the LORD, do all these things.'

C. It is in the trials that you Know Yahweh

**Philippians 3:10 (NKJV)** <sup>10</sup> that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death
