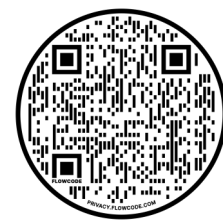

Lifestyle Evangelism

As Christmas and the New Year [2026] is looming just around the corner, let's each one take the challenge to be the "ambassador" for Christ (2nd Corinthians 5:20) that Christ desires us to be.

As ambassadors or representatives, we will be people who are imitating Christ in the best way we each know. Paul tells the Corinthian church in 1st Corinthians 4:16, "Therefore I urge you to imitate him." Why Paul? Because he was very conscious of how he lived before them. God wanted Paul to be his missionary to the lost world (the Gentiles) and Paul was willing to do this and lived his life in that way. Other places that challenge each of us to live as Christ (as Paul and others model Him) are: 2nd Thessalonians 3:9 and Philippians 4:9.
