Mother's Day

Where did Mother's Day come from? While naysayers have tried to identify this holiday with past pagan rituals, the truth is Mother's Day began as a day to honor good Christian moms. Anna M. Jarvis (1864-1948) is credited with bringing in the celebration of Mother's day with the first observance at a church service held on May 10, 1908. The idea itself did not take long to be spread to churches all over.

We find this command in Exodus 20:12: "Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the LORD your God is giving you."
