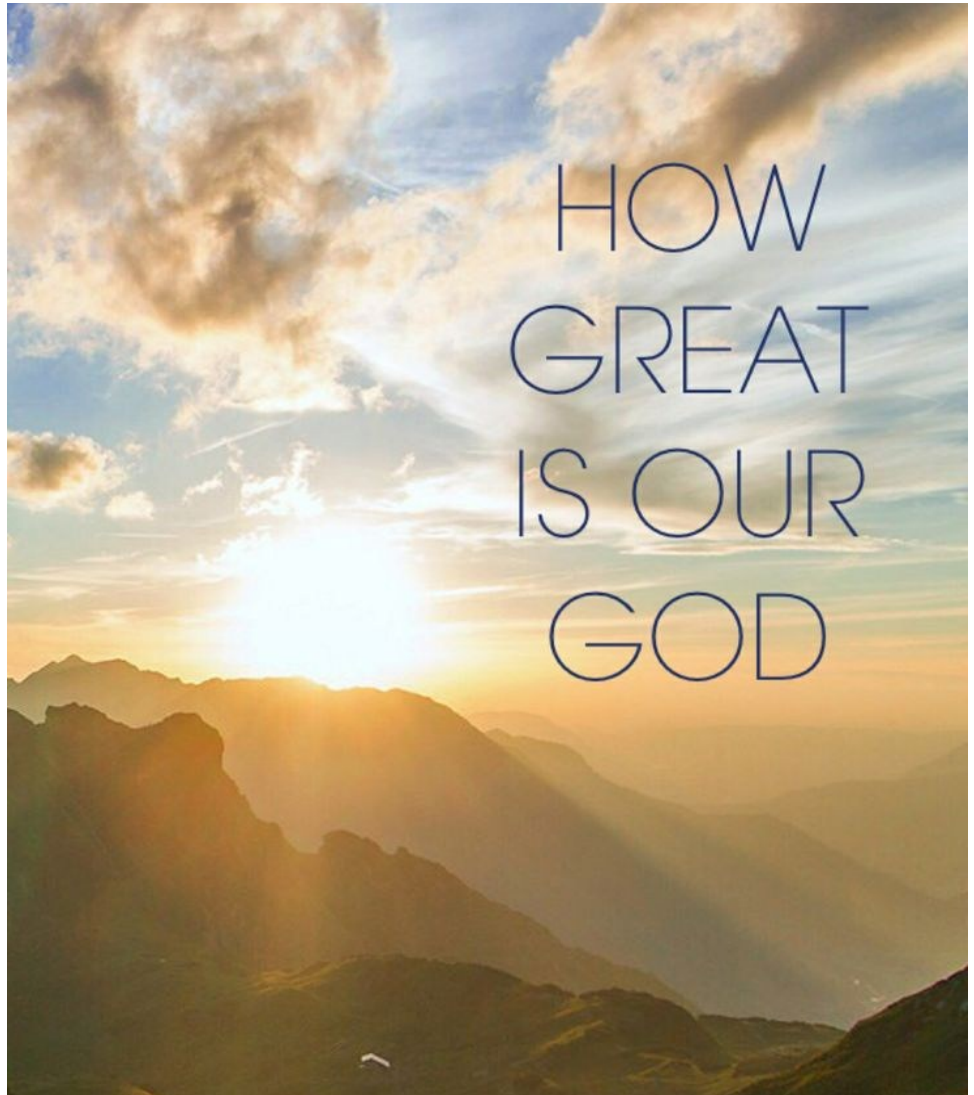

The other day, I read about a Christian man who literally kept a daily book account with the Lord. On one side he recorded all he did for God, and on the other side he recorded what the Lord did for him. If a friend helped or cheered him, he put that down. If he was sick and recovered he put that down. If his prayers were answered, he wrote it down. All favors and mercies he recorded. After a few weeks of this bookkeeping, he gave it up. "It's no use," he said, "I can never get a balance. I am always hopelessly in debt."

Isn't that true of all of us. We are forever in God's debt. We are in debt to God for our salvation. We didn't deserve it. We hadn't earned it. Yet, "God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten son that whosoever believeth on him should not perish, but have eternal life" (John 3:16).
