Practicing Prayer

Sunday, September 14, immediately following our potluck lunch we are planning a time of prayer and singing. It was said in Life Groups last Sunday, "Be thinking of your prayer requests this week...not the physically ill or mission efforts (we already do an outstanding job of lifting these up), but spiritually deep needs and concerns." Remember what Jesus says in Mark 11:20-25 As they passed by in the morning, they saw the fig tree withered away to its roots. And Peter remembered and said to him, "Rabbi, look! The fig tree that you cursed has withered." And Jesus answered them, "Have faith in God. Truly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be taken up and thrown into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that what he says will come to pass, it will be done for him. Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours. And whenever you stand praying, forgive, if you have anything against anyone, so that your Father also who is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses."

In an email recently (from Discovering Truths Ministries), I read about a "Prayer Practice Guide" using the powerful A.C.T.S. framework. Here is that framework as we think about praying, not only this Sunday, but every day!

- 1. A Adoration. Praise to God. "Reflect on His greatness, His goodness, and His unchanging character. Honor Him for who He is & celebrate the amazing things He has done."
- 2. C Confession. Come to God with honesty & humility. "Acknowledge the sins you've committed against Him & others. Lay your heart bare."
- 3. T Thanksgiving. Express your gratitude. "Thank God for His countless blessings, His faithfulness in your life, & the ways He continues to provide, protect, & guide you."
- 4. S Supplication. With confidence bring your needs & concerns to God. Remember this is not only the physical aspects of life, but also the spiritual aspects as well.

I look forward to this Sunday as we continue to talk about the Armor of God. We will be placing the "Shoes of peace" on our guy. We will then eat together and pray together. Please come this Sunday!
