

Connect (15min)

* EASTER'S a Comin'

Do you & your family have any Easter traditions? How you prepare for and celebrate Good Friday & Easter? What are your plans for this Good Friday & Easter Weekend? Are you inviting anyone to Church with you? Pray: Take a couple of minutes as a Group to pray for the people your Group is inviting.

Sunday Message Feedback (40min)

* Pastor Shawn continues our LIFE 101 series in 1 Peter.

Special Note on This Week's Topic of Marriage: Although marriage is the focus be sure to include those who are single in your Group discussion as it is designed to be helpful for all of us regardless of our marital status.

- 1. Love & Marriage go together like a...
 - a. What is one of your favorite love songs, and why? Discuss.
 - b. Name as many famous marriages as you can (as a Group) in 1 minute.

2. Read 1 Corinthians 7:27-28

- Shawn pointed out that this verse illustrated that marriage is a commitment to a life of trouble.
 Have you seen that to be true in your own marriage, or if you are not married have you seen trouble in those you know who are married? Discuss.
- LOVE IS: Go around your group and have each person finish the following statement: Love is _______.
 Read 1 Corinthians 13:4-7
 - a. Why do you think Paul begins defining love by telling us that it is patient? Discuss.
 - **b.** Have you ever thought about this chapter on love as a description that helps you deal with the troubles that come in relationships (of any kind)? Discuss.

4. This week Shawn made it clear that love is a choice and not an emotion.
Can you come up with some things that you have done to choose to love someone, even though you didn't feel like it? Have you ever been on the receiving end of that kind of unconditional love? Explain.

"Our culture has accepted two huge lies. The first is that if you disagree with someone's lifestyle, you must fear or hate them. The second is that to love someone means you agree with everything they believe or do. Both are nonsense. You don't have to compromise convictions to be compassionate." — Rick Warren

- 5. <u>Submission</u> is one of those things that can be hard to talk about and even harder to practice, yet the Bible tells us to submit to one another. Fortunately, the Bible gives us some instruction on what it looks like to put someone else's needs above our own. Read <u>Ephesians 5:1-2, 21-33</u> and <u>Philippians 2:5-11</u> and talk about how we can "imitate" God's love and Christ's attitude.
- 6. **Christ's love for the church** is not just a great example of submission, it also shows how it was meant to be a model of how men should love their wives.

What are some things that keep people today from truly loving others in this extreme way?

7. We got a clear message this week that love is a choice and that it cannot be built upon emotion. At the same time, God gave us the capacity to experience a wide range of feelings/emotions. Read the following passages and note in your own words what feelings can be a result of a loving marriage.

Proverbs 5:15-19

Song of Songs 4:9-10

- a. Can you think of any dangers associated with making these kinds of feelings the 'ultimate goal' of a marriage?
- b. Marriage on Mission: What do you think the Goal of Marriage is according to God's design & purpose?

Application & **Prayer** (20min)

What might it look like for you, personally, if you lived your life "deeply considering" those around you? >> If you are married how would it change your marriage? Discuss.

PRAY with and for marriages in your group and in our church.

This Week: Read 1 Peter 3:1-12

Ask Jesus to help you "deeply consider" those you are in relationship with.
