THANKFUL 3 – Take 3min on your own to consider and write down 1 thing you are Thankful for in each of these 3 areas
1. In my relationship with God: "I am Thankful
2. In my relationships with others (spouse/family/friends): "I am Thankful
3. In my physical provisions (health/work/finances/provisions): "I am Thankful
*Then get into groups of 3 and share your Thankful 3 with one another.

FOCUS - Read Psalm 103 -- then take 3 minutes to praise & thank God in Prayer in your group of 3.

Sunday Message Feedback (35-45min)

*Speaker: Shawn Vandop – Lead Pastor. Message: <u>PERSEVERE</u> – Part 3.

- **1. Bounce Back:** *Comeback & Redemption Themes* are big part of human narratives in books, movies, sports.
 - **a.** What is one of your favorite *Comeback/Redemption* stories in books, movies or sports?
 - **b.** Talk about a time when <u>you</u> had to bounce back or get-up from a fall or failure of some kind. What did you learn from the experience? (...about life, about God, about yourself)
 - **c.** How many examples of people in the Bible can you think of who messed up but God restored and still used for His glory? What do you notice about those people? What do you notice about God?
- 2. What jumped out at you from this past Sunday's Message? What encouraged or challenged you?
- 3. Redemption of the Rock *The Story of Peter*
 - **a. Read Matthew 4:18-20** Jesus called Peter, along with a few others, to come follow Him. What calling has God placed on your life? In what ways are you living it out?
 - b. Read Luke 22:7-34 & 22:54-65

Can you relate to Peter? When have you kept silent instead of standing up for what you believe? What was the underlying fear that caused you to do that?

c. Read John 21:1-17

How does Peter's Story and the Resurrection of Jesus highlight God's redeeming work & heart for us?

4. Read Isaiah 30:18; Ephesians 2:8-10 & Philippians 1:3-11

How does God's character & work inspire <u>PERSEVERANCE</u> in our lives to deal with our failures? What has God done for you? What is He doing for you? What does He provide?

Application & Prayer (15-20min)

1. a. Looking Back

What is one thing in your life that you thought you'd never recover from?

—an illness, a broken relationship, a job loss, a death? How did that pain impact you?

How have you seen redemption at work through that situation?

b. Looking Forward

Because of Jesus, we can have hope that the best is yet to come. But in the midst of pain, doubt, and failure, it can be difficult to believe that. Take a moment and make a list of a few things that you're looking forward to in the coming weeks and months—what you're excited about and what makes you feel hopeful. If nothing comes to mind, plan something that brings you joy. Share one or two things with your group.

2. **Read & MEMORIZE**: <u>1 Corinthians 2:9</u> -- How does this verse inspire & equip us to persevere?

No eye has seen, no ear has heard, and no mind has imagined what God has prepared for those who love Him.

3. Engaging God this Week:

What is your plan for engaging Jesus this week? Do you have a set time/place & plan for reading & prayer? How is this personal discipline going for you lately and how can we encourage or pray for you in this area?

4. PRAYER: Break into groups of 3-4 or Men/Women to enhance the opportunity for sharing and prayer.

*Based on our discussion and the topic of Perseverance, how can we Pray for you personally? *Pray for the person on your right.
