Connect (30min)

- Spring-Cleaning On a scale of 1-10 (loathe it to love it) how much do you enjoy Spring-Cleaning?
 What is one of the key things on your Spring-Cleaning list this year?
- 2. Tool Time What is one of your favorite household tools? What is one tool that you wish you had this season? Have you ever tried to do a job/task, but lacked the right tools to do it? Briefly share your story.

Message Discussion (35min)

1. Message Feedback

- a. Read <u> Ephesians 3:14-21</u> and open with prayer.
- **b.** How was your awareness of the Holy Spirit's presence this past week?
- c. What jumped out at you from Sunday's message? What thoughts or questions did you walk away with?
- **d.** What would you do if you saw someone you love doing something that you knew there was a much easier way to do it?

2. Three Baptisms

*What were the Three Baptisms available to all believers that Shawn taught us about?

- a. The Holy Spirit baptizes us in Christ. (Salvation)
 - > What was your life like before Christ and how did the Holy Spirit lead you to Jesus?
- b. Another believer baptizes us in water. (Separation)
 - > According to Acts 2:41, what should we do after we believe?
 - > Have you been baptized as a believer? If you have been baptized, why was it important for you to do it?
- c. Jesus baptizes us in the Holy Spirit. (Supernatural Power)
 - > Why do you think Jesus told the disciples in Luke 24:49 to wait for the Holy Spirit?
 - > When was the last time that you undeniably saw the Holy Spirit's power at work in or around you?
 - *How many of these *Baptisms* have you personally experienced?

3. Be Filled

- **a.** Shawn used an illustration of milk and chocolate syrup to explain how the Holy Spirit works in our lives. In doing so, he demonstrated that the Holy Spirit is <u>first WITH us</u>, then once we receive Christ, He <u>dwells IN us</u>, and then we are commanded to continually be filled with the Holy Spirit so that He can <u>be UPON us</u>. Discuss... What are your thoughts on this explanation of the Holy Spirit's work in our lives? Has this been your experience?
- **b.** Read \square Ephesians 5:15-20.
 - i. What jumps out at you from these verses? What do you learn?
 - ii. Have you ever thought of being filled with the Spirit as a command? Why/why not?
 - iii. Is it a command you can fulfill on your own? What does this tell you about the Christian life?
 - iv. Why do you think Paul uses a negative example (drunkenness) to describe a positive outcome? (being filled with the Spirit).
- **c.** How does the filling of the Holy Spirit confirm the truth that...
 - "It's better to have the Holy Spirit IN you than to have Jesus BESIDE you"? Discuss.
- d. Why is being filled with the Holy Spirit so important to living the Christian life?

- a. Have you ever asked the Holy Spirit to fill you? Would you ask the Holy Spirit to fill you?
