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## Connect (25min)

### 1. BIG KIDS

- What's a childhood moment when you learned a "grown-up" lesson - like discovering taxes on a purchase?

### 2. SUMMER PLAYLIST

- What are you currently reading, listening to, or watching - for enrichment or entertainment?  
Share your feedback on one or two sources you're currently engaging. *Books, Music, Podcasts, Shows...*

### 3. SUMMER PSALM

- **Read [Psalm 84](#).** Take a few minutes to praise and thank the Lord together in response to this Psalm.

## Message Discussion (50min)

### 1. TABLE TALK

- The people in Sunday's story were basically served "filet-o-fish" sandwiches...  
What is your favorite kind of sandwich?
- What's the largest group of people you've ever had to prepare or serve a meal for?

### 2. WHEN NOT ENOUGH IS MORE THAN ENOUGH

- **Read [Luke 9:10-17](#).** How would you describe the location and atmosphere of this "Table Talk"?
- What do you learn about Jesus? What do you learn about the guests?
- Jesus told the disciples, "You feed them."  
Why do you think He challenged them instead of solving it immediately Himself?
- The disciples had just returned from a successful ministry trip, yet they still doubted.  
Where do you see yourself in that tension between recent faith victories and current doubts?
- What stood out to you in the way Jesus partnered with the disciples to meet the crowd's needs?  
How does that shape your view of how God wants to use you?

### 3. NOT ENOUGH

- When have you felt like what you had—your time, energy, or faith—just wasn't enough?
- What's something small you can bring to Jesus right now that you've been tempted to withhold because it didn't feel like enough?
- If Jesus multiplies what we bring, what would abundance look like in that area of your life?

### 4. MORE THAN ENOUGH

- Why do you think Jesus chooses to involve us in the miracle, even though He could do it all on His own?
- How does the truth—"Jesus will always do the heavy lifting"—change how you can face your challenges?

## Reflection & Prayer (15min)

### REFLECTION

- Think of a moment when Jesus took what little you had and did more than you imagined. How can you use that story to encourage someone else this week?

READ  [Ephesians 3:14-21](#).

### PRAYER

\*Break into groups of 3-4.

- **Thank** God for what He's already done with "not enough".
- **Ask** for faith and courage to bring what you have, no matter how small.
- **Believe** Jesus will do more than enough.
- **Pray** for one person in your life who needs a miracle.  
(for salvation, healing, provision, protection, blessing...)
