Sunday Message Feedback (35-40min)

1. While Growing Up...

a. Did you tend to follow the rules, go with the flow or push the boundaries?

- b. What was one area that you and your parents went back and forth on while you grew up in their home?
- <u>Read Luke 15:11-32</u> &/or <u>Watch</u> this passage/parable on <u>LUMO Project Gospel of Luke 15:11-32</u> (YouTube-4min.).
 a. How do you initially connect with each of the main characters: The Father, the Younger Son, the Older Brother?
 - b. What is the root of the younger son's rebellion?What areas in your life can you lean towards being rebellious?
 - **c.** What is the root/motive of the older brother's response to his father and younger brother? How was he rebellious or religious towards his father? How have you been like the older brother in life?

"Neither son loved the father for himself. They both were using the father for their own self-centered ends rather than loving, enjoying, and serving him for his own sake. This means that you can rebel against God and be alienated from him either by breaking his rules or by keeping all of them diligently. It's a shocking message: Careful obedience to God's law may serve as a strategy for rebelling against God." – Timothy Keller.

- d. What do we learn about the Father in this story? Read <u>Psalm 145:8-9</u> and <u>1 Corinthians 13:4-7</u>.
 *How does the father in the parable line up with these descriptions of love?
 *What does Jesus teach us about Father God through him?
- **e.** When dealing with people, are you a "*fix it*" person or a "*let them struggle to fix it*" person? What are the positives and negatives of both?

- **3.** Point from Sunday: When our children rebel, we should *pray, don't burn bridges* (express your love), and *wait*. Which of these three instructions are the hardest for you to demonstrate?
 - a. Do you agree with this statement? "Rules without relationship equals rebellion." Discuss.
 - **b.** When are the best times to shape the will without breaking the spirit?

c. When your child/relative/friend comes back into relationship, is it hard for you to grant forgiveness and show grace?

- 4. Read <u>Luke 19:10</u> "...seek & save the lost." & <u>John 10:10</u> "The thief's purpose is to steal, kill & destroy." Shawn stated that "Satan hates your kids. If he can't get to you, he will try to get to them."
 a. How does this statement move you?
 - b. How can parents respond, knowing Satan is on attack?

5. Read Proverbs 3:1-6

- **a.** List the blessings found in these verses.
- **b.** How are we instructed to teach these truths?
- c. As a group share ways you can live out & teach others these truths (including your children).
