 - *How are these verses relevant to the Christmas story? Discuss.

 - *Which of Herod's actions stand out the most to you?

- 6. Why is pursuing power and position so prevalent in our society today? Discuss.
 - *Share about a time when your pursuit of power/position, paranoia or worry led you to a cruel action. How did that make you feel? How did the other person/people feel?
- 7. King Herod was battling for his Throne. He did not want to give it up.
 - *In what parts of your life have you tried hard to keep Jesus from being King?
 - *What part of your life are you keeping Jesus from sitting on the throne?
 - *Where have you treated Jesus as a threat to your "kingdom"?
