 2 Truths & a Lie: Have each Group member share two true things and one false thing about themselves, or something they've done (the goal in this game is to try to deceive the group). After 1 person shares have the group vote for which one is false.

2. John 18:38 – "What is Truth?" Pilate asked.

Do you think it is hard to know the truth in the culture we live? Why/why not? How have things changed in your life time? Are there things that people believed to be true at one time and now no longer are true? What are some examples? Discuss.

3. Honest Questions

Shawn talked about the Bible being The Standard for Truth - yet many have a hard time explaining why. **a.** Do you find it hard to trust the Bible? Why/why not?

- i. Should we really believe something just because the Bible tells us so?
- ii. What role does the Bible play in your faith? If you read it, why do you read it?
- iii. What does it contribute to your relationship with God?

b. Do you find that people (including yourself) apply the same criteria (questions, expectations, skepticism...) to other historical documents or teaching? Why or why not?

4. Shawn gave some reasons on why we can Trust the Bible. Do you remember what they were?

- a. What is Manuscript Evidence? How does it support the credibility of the Bible?
- b. What is Archaeological Evidence? How does it support the Historical Accuracy of the Bible?
- c. How do we deal with "new information" that arises that contradicts the Bible record?

Food-for-Thought:

"Before the Old and New Testaments were combined and called the Bible, the debate about the Christian faith <u>centered on an event</u>, not a book. We believe Jesus rose from the dead, but not (just) because the Bible says so. We believe because of the testimony of eyewitnesses who gave up everything— including their lives—because of their confidence in Jesus." – Andy Stanley.

5. Do you think people may reject the Bible more often because of what it says about them? Discuss. How has the Bible been painfully accurate in your life in what it says about who you are and what you nature is. Has the Bible ever influenced your thoughts or actions? Share some examples.

Read 2 Timothy 3:16-17 & Discuss -- How can this verse help you trust the Bible?

All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. God uses it to prepare and equip His people to do every good work.
