4. Without A Doubt:

This weekend we heard the good news that doubt does not necessarily mean a person lacks faith. With that said, <u>doubt</u> often times can do one of two things –

1.) It either causes us to seek God, ultimately instilling a greater belief in what he can do, or

2.) It leaves us stuck in our own lack of movement or disobedience, wondering if God will really show up.

How might the following verses help build your confidence in God in the midst of doubt?

a. <u>Psalm 145:9-10</u> b. <u>Psalm 25:8</u> c. <u>Psalm 89:11</u> d. <u>James 1:17</u> e. <u>Romans 1:19-20</u>

*Which one of these verses is most important for you to remember right now, and why?

 5. Pastor Shawn told us that faith is simply trusting God enough to do what he says. Another way to think about it is - to understand that obedience is better than faith. Throughout the Bible, God provides us with motivation to do what he says and continue on! What motivations do you find in the following passages - to keep obeying and pushing forward?

 a. 1 Corinthians 15:58
 b. Hebrews 12:1-3
 c. 2 Timothy 4:6-8

*Discuss which passage speaks or encourages you the most.

- 6. It's often during times of hardship and challenge that we want God to rescue us and are most often tempted to doubt his plan. But the Bible teaches that hardships can play an important role in developing our faith. How do the following passages help us understand the role of hardship and the attitude God wants us to have toward it?
 - a. <u>Romans 5:3-5</u> b. <u>James 1:2-4</u> c. <u>Romans 8:38</u>

*Can you think of any examples from our own life where knowing the truth of these passages has helped your faith be "active" and "life changing?"
