- 2. When you think of a spiritually mature person what comes to mind?
 - Or how would you describe a spiritually mature person?
- 3. Pastor Shawn talked about <u>two myths</u> about spiritual maturity and growth.
 Can you think of any ways your understanding of spiritual growth and maturity has changed over time?
 Explain.
- 4. Just as physical growth varies for all of us the same is true for spiritual growth.

 Which of the following words could be used to describe your spiritual growth journey (currently)? Why?

[growing, falling, refreshed, just beginning, consistent, rebellious, hasn't started yet, starting over, going backwards, confused, struggling, other...]

5. We spent time on Sunday looking at what the Apostle Peter had to say about spiritual maturity and we will end our life group study by revisiting his teaching. The Apostle Paul also had some things to say about spiritual growth and maturity in his letter to the Thessalonians who like Peters audience were dealing with suffering and persecution. Read <u>1 Thessalonians 1:1-10</u>

- **a.** How does Paul describe the faith of the Thessalonians?
- **b.** What is most attractive to you about how they lived out their faith?
- **c.** How do you think they were able to mature is such a difficult situation (being persecuted)?
- 6. Following Jesus and spiritual growth are things that involve both God's Spirit working in our lives from the inside out, and us working on how God calls us to live (see <u>Philippians 2:12-13</u>). The process of maturing can be hard work. Paul often used the analogy of athletic competition to help Christians understand their part in growing to maturity.

How do the following verses increase or affirm your understanding of what it takes to develop a spiritually mature perspective?

- a. Philippians 3:13-14
- b. 1 Corinthians 9:24-27
- c. 2 Timothy 2:4-5
- d. Hebrews 12:1-2
- 7. This weekend, we heard how spiritual growth is measured not by how much we know, but rather by how we live. <u>1 Thessalonians 5:12-18</u> gives a list of great things to know and live out as we follow Jesus and impact those around us.

As you read the list, which one or two have you seen or do you think would push you toward the most growth?

Read <u>1 Peter 1:22-25</u> and <u>1 Peter 2:1-3</u>

- *Looking back at the four areas people should see a difference in (Love, Speech, Attitude and Desires), which one has challenged you the most?
- *Share where you need to grow more in your walk with God and use that as a point of prayer for one another.
