- * What are 1-2 things you've learned and applied from your devotions this past week?

- * Pastor Shawn begins our short series called MONEY TALKS.
- If money could talk what do you think it would say?

- 2. Are you comfortable talking about money? Do you tend to worry about money? Why/why not?
- 3. Our Life in a Dresser Pastor Shawn talked about how easy it is to compartmentalize our lives.

 He used the illustration of a dresser and its drawers. The danger in compartmentalizing our life is that we lose the truth of the Christian life by failing to make Jesus Lord of everything. Do you tend to compartmentalize your faith? If so, do you tend to keep your finances away from God? If so, why? Why do we tend to keep the drawer of finances closed to God? Discuss.
- 4. "The way we spend money is a good indicator of who we love."

 How and when do you see this most clearly in your life?
- 5. The Truth in our Treasures

Read Matthew 6:19-21. What sticks out to you about these verses?

Read verse 21 again. We sometimes think of this concepts backwards: Where my heart is, my treasure will go. We think that if we have a good heart, our money will naturally follow. But this verse says that what we do with our money is the indicator of where our heart is. Can you give an example of this? **Read Matthew 6:24**.

- a. How is this statement from Jesus true? Can you think of any examples in your own life? Read Matthew 6:25-34
- b. How does living a life of generosity release the hold of fear and worry on our lives? Discuss.

6. The Heart of the Issue

When God asks for a tithe (**Read Deut. 14:23 & Malachi 3:6-10**), it's not because He needs it. God doesn't need us to give money to His work. What He wants is our heart. How does tithing (giving 10% of your income to God's work through your church) follow the teaching of Jesus in Matthew 6:21?

7. Spare Some Change?

Take a few minutes and discuss what your church/community could be like if we all followed this command of God to live generous lives. How would our hearts change? How would the world change?

Application & Prayer (20min)

The order of Stewardship/Budgeting we see taught by God throughout Scripture is *Give-Save-Live* (or Spend). The typical order of Stewardship/Budgeting practiced in the world is *Spend-Save-Give*. (with saving and giving being rare, if not non-existent components)

- a. How have you experienced the impact of these two contrasting paths in our world, and perhaps your own life/family?
- b. How would your life, the church, and our society change if we intentionally decided to live with God's plan?
 - 1. Give decide in purpose & details advance, make this the first step in your budget (by % usually works best)
 - 2. Save decide in purpose & details advance...
 - 3. Live live off what remains, again with healthy purpose and practice. Get some coaching if needed.
