Connect (10min)

Read Ephesians 6:10-18 & Open in Prayer

*Option 1: Our Stories -- Have 1-2 people share the 'coles-notes' version of their story (5-7min each). *Option 2: What is 1 Thing you are Thankful for today? What is 1 thing we don't know about you yet?

Check-In (5-10min)

*Where have you been reading in the Bible this past week? (eg. Good Book Reading Plan or Other) What are 1 or 2 things you learned, or that challenged you, or that encouraged you?

*What is 1 thing/area that you've been praying for in your personal relationship with God? What is 1 way He has spoken to you or answered you in through these prayers?

Sunday Message Feedback (30-40min)

1. Candy Bowl

If there was a big bowl of all the usual Halloween candy/treats, which 1 would pick out first?

2. What impacted you from Sunday's message by Pastor Shawn?

: What challenged or encouraged you, and why? : What can you apply to your faith & life this week? How?

3. Have you ever considered that your relationship with God would be challenged by an enemy? What is your view of the Devil? How do you, or have you pictured him?

*The Old & New Testament, and Jesus Himself, make it abundantly clear that the spiritual realm is real, including the Devil, and angelic forces of darkness & light. There is a spiritual battle, and we and in the midst of it whether we realize it or not.

4. Read Isaiah 14:12-14 and Revelation 12:7-9. What do these Scriptures tell us about the Devil?

Jesus tells us that "the thief comes to steal, kill and destroy" (John 10:10). How have you seen this truth in your life or those around you? What does the Devil steal, kill and destroy.

Read <u>Acts 26:18</u> - What is a key component of Jesus' mission for the Apostle Paul at his conversion?

5. Read <u>1 Peter 5:8</u>

What does this verse tell you about the devil? How do you "stay alert" to his attacks and lies? Do you have a strategy? Discuss...

6. Read Genesis 3:1-7

- **a.** Shawn showed us that the enemy has different strategies that he uses to get our focus off God. As we read them consider which one connects with your journey the most.
 - He gets you to drift away by being subtle. (Genesis 3:1) Devil never deals with the obvious he is always subtle.
 - He twists the voice and the Word of God (Genesis 3:1) Did God really say that?...
 - He asks the wrong questions rather than the right questions (Genesis 3:1) He knows how to ask a question that will cause you to doubt or even blame God.
 - He gets us talking with him (Genesis 3:2-3) Even engaged the serpent in a conversation and things went bad.
 - He will get you to focus on many things rather than the ONE thing (Genesis 3:1) God will always put His finger on the one thing in your life that hinders your relationship with Him.
- **b.** Which of these strategies has the Devil been successful in using in your life? Which one do you identify with most? Why?

7. Read John 8:44

- a. What terms does Jesus use to describe the Devil in this passage of Scripture?
- b. How would you define the "father of lies"? What does that phrase mean to you?

8. Read John 17:15-19

What does this prayer of Jesus teach us about being free from the strategies and strongholds of the Devil?

Application

Our Hearing God Workshop & Set Free Retreats are part of the equipping & experience we encourage you to have because they help prepare us for life and ministry in this world.
