2. So how do we live a Godly life? (this is a big question) READ 2 Peter 1:5-7 & 1 Peter 1:13-16 - Focus on Godliness

- Let's face it, living a godly life is not EASY or POPULAR in today's world—but it is possible. Not only is it possible to live a godly life but God actually expects it to develop in us
- New Life (2 Corinthians 5:17) & Transformation (Romans 12:2) become hallmarks of those who have been saved by God and are following the leadership of Jesus in their daily lives.

- **Our Example** - It is a wondrous mystery & truth, that Jesus is fully Human & fully God. He represents God perfectly (Colossians 1:15-20; 2:9) - because He is God, <u>and</u> He also models for us a new way (godly way) to be human (Romans 5:12-21; Heb. 4:15), and holy...as He is holy.

*What made is possible for JESUS to live a holy-human life in an un-holy world?

(Perfect relationship with the Father & Holy Spirit...)

*How did He do it? How can/does He help us? (eg. Romans 5:1-5)

(Grace & Forgiveness, Presence & Power of His Holy Spirit, Truth of His Word/Bible, Strength of Community...)

READ Psalm 145:8-9 & Lamentations 3:22-24

*How does the character & presence of God, highlighted in these verses, help/encourage us?

How would you describe the difference between Religious & Relational Christianity?

eg. Trying to be holy so God chooses me or loves me more...

vs Being holy because God already loves & chose me.

3. <u>HOLY MOLY</u>! What does the word <u>HOLY</u> mean?

God's Moral perfection, separated from evil and *distinctive* in *character;* <u>devoted to the service of God</u>.

Pastor Mike said, 'When I hear this definition I think of two words - 'Set Apart"

: To be <u>set apart</u>! To have a love & hunger for the things of God and to walk in the ways of God. (To be different than the way I was or could be, different than the world, a light in a dark world)

(Quote by D.L. Moody)

"A holy Life will make the deepest impression. Lighthouses blow no horns they just SHINE!"

4. Train Ourselves to be Godly.

1 Timothy 4:7-8

⁷ Do not waste time arguing over godless ideas and old wives' tales. Instead, **train yourself** <u>to be</u> <u>**godly**</u>. ⁸ "Physical training is good, <u>but training for godliness is much better</u>, promising benefits in this life and in the life to come."

A godly person should train in & represent Godly Characteristics:

Examples -- Being Devoted to God, and Showing...

Humility - To humble ourselves before God
Forgiveness - Because God has forgiven us, over and over again.
Graciousness - through God's Grace we have been saved
Unconditional Love - READ John 15:12 - Jesus said, Love each other as I have Loved you.
