## Connect (30min)

- 1. CHECK IN: (Break into groups of 2-3 or Men/Women)
  - \* 🛄 Read Mark 12:28-31. Mind Body Spirit

## 2. PRAY FIRST

% How has your PRAY FIRST experience been this past week? Share your feedback or highlights.

**Read** <u>Psalm 42</u>. Have one person read for this scripture for the group. Use this Psalm as a guide for prayer.

A Pray – Let's take 10min to P.R.A.Y. together. Leader – time & transition to each component.

- -- <u>P</u>ause (be still & listen. 2min) -- <u>R</u>ejoice (praise & thanks. 2min.),
- -- <u>A</u>sk (invite & request 4min.)
- -- <u>Y</u>ield (surrender & trust. 2min)
- > Moments of silence are ok.

## Message Discussion (45min)

## 1. THE SUBJECT OF SUFFERING

- a. In your experience (without all the details), which kind of suffering has been the worst and why?
  \*Physical \*Mental/Emotional \*Relational \*Financial \*Spiritual \*Being a Canucks fan \*Other...
- **b.** How do you tend to respond to pain and suffering; our own, and to others'?

> Have you ever "meant well," but what you said or did wasn't helpful?

c. How have the following components of your faith helped you engage the reality of suffering?

\*The Bible \*The suffering of Jesus \*Worship \*Prayer \*Serving others \*Christian community \*Other...

d. If someone asked you – "If God is good, then why is there so much suffering in the world?"

- how would you respond?

2. MESSAGE RECAP: What jumped out at you from Sunday's message? What encouraged or challenged you?

## 3. WORD []] Read <u>Romans 8:18-30</u>

- a. What do you learn from this passage of Scripture about Suffering?
- b. What do you learn about God? What do you learn about people?

## 4. THREE LIES ABOUT SUFFERING

a. What were the three lies Christians believe about suffering that Pastor Shawn talked about?

- b. Which one stands out to you the most, and why? c. Have you believed any of these lies?
  - i. A godly life is a pain free life ii. If you are suffering, you are sinning

iii. There is always something good hiding behind the bad

#### 5. ALL CREATION

- a. What do 🛄 verses 18-23 tell us about suffering?
- **b.** What does it mean that *all creation* is suffering? What are some evidences of this reality?
- c. Paul describes what you could call "a light at the end of the tunnel" when it comes to suffering.
  - What specific details about this 'light at the end of the tunnel" does Paul give us (see v.23).

#### 6. SUFFERING & PRAYER

#### III Reread Romans 8:26-27

- **a.** Have you ever had a moment when you didn't even know what to pray? How did you deal with that?
- **b.** How does the Holy Spirit help us in such situation?
- c. How should this insight about the Holy Spirit help us in our prayer life?

#### 7. FOR GOOD

#### III Reread Romans 8:28-30

- a. To whom does the truth of this passage apply? Who benefits from this verse?
- b. How could it be painful to quote Romans 8:28 to someone amid suffering?
- **c.** *Paul is helping us understand that for those who love God, in every circumstance we are regaining what we lost.* How does this impact the way you look at suffering?
- **d.** Sometimes we can see in the short-term how God has worked for our good in suffering. In other experiences, we are unable to see how God has worked, even after many years.
  - i. What is an example of a time when you have seen God's hand at work for your good?
  - ii. Is there anything you've been wrestling with where you still haven't been able to see God's hand?
- **e.** Paul seems to make it clear that much of the good God will bring about through our suffering will not be experienced till we are with Jesus in eternity.
  - i. Is that difficult for you to accept? Why/why not?
  - ii. Why do you think God planned it that way in many cases of suffering?

## Prayer (15min)

- 🔥 Pray "Holy Spirit, please speak to us through Your Word and empower us to pray for one another."
- III Read John 16:33, 2 Corinthians 1:3-11 & Revelation 21:1-6
- In response to God's Word our discussion together, what is one way that we can pray for you?
  > Perhaps for Healing in a specific area? *Physical, Mental, Spiritual, Relational...*
- Break into groups of 3-4 people (or men & women) to pray for one another.
