Connect (30min)

*For Connect and Prayer -- break into two groups, or groups of 3-4 people to enhance participation.

1. HIGHLIGHT & HOPE

- **a.** Share 1 *Highlight* that stands to you in your life from the month of January.
- **b.** Share 1 thing you are *Hopeful & Praying for* in the month of February.

2. FOCUS

- a.
 Read <u>2 Chronicles 7:14</u> and <u>1 Peter 2:4-10</u>.
- **b. 5min Focus:** Respond to these scriptures and open your discussion time with 5min of open group prayer.

Message Discussion (35min)

1. PRAY FIRST 2024 – 21 Days of Prayer & Fasting. January 8-28.

- **a.** Were you able to participate in our *Prayer Summit* on Sunday night? Share your experience and feedback.
- b. Share your feedback from your *Pray First* experience last week, and overall:How were you encouraged and challenged? What did you learn? What will you apply moving forward?

2. THE POWER OF CORPORATE PRAYER

- a. Why do you think God honors the corporate prayer meeting?
- b. How does corporate prayer impact your personal walk with God?
- c. How does corporate prayer impact our shared journey and community of faith?
- d. How does corporate prayer keep us focused and dependent on God as a church?

3. THE POWER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

- a. 🛄 Read John 16:5-11.
 - i. What do you learn about the *Trinity* in this passage? (Father-Son-Holy Spirit)
 - ii. What do you learn about our relationship with God?
- **b.** Why is it better that Jesus left, and the Holy Spirit came? How is that better for us?

4. THE EARLY CHURCH

- a.
 Read <u>Acts 1:1-8 and Acts 1:12-14</u>
- **b.** How was the church birthed? What did it start with? (prayer)
- c. Why do you think God started His worldwide movement with a prayer meeting? What does that tell us about God and prayer?
- d. If corporate prayer is part of God's plans and purposes for His church, who do so many people resist it? Discuss.

5. OUR CHURCH

- **a.** What do you think would happen if our church got serious about praying together? What do you think God would do? *Imagine and share together* (Ephesians 3:14-21)
- b. How is Life Group prayer a key part of corporate prayer in our lives and church?
 What are some other examples of corporate prayer at MSC, and how are they important?
 > Prayer Summit, Sunday Service Prayer (Preservice and Post-service Prayer), various Ministry Team Prayer, Set Free Retreat Prayer, Empower Retreat Prayer...
- c. What are you willing to do to make corporate prayer a value in your life and church?
