5. Share the Reading of <u>1 Corinthians 15</u>

a. Why is the Resurrection of Jesus Christ so crucial, so pivotal, so transformational... in history, and in/for your life?

He is the 'first fruits,' the pioneer of life,' He has forced open a door that has been locked since the death of the first man & woman. He has met, fought, and beaten the King of Death. - c. Who else in your life needs to hear and believe this Good News? How might Jesus change them?
