Table Talk LIFE CHANGING MEALS WITH JUSIUS

Connect (25min)

1. LOVE STORIES

- What is one of your favorite *Love Stories* (real or fictional), and why?
- If you could visit any castle or palace in the world, which one would you choose and why?

2. LOVE CHAPTER

Read 1 Corinthians 13:4-7.

Take a few minutes to praise and thank the Lord together in response to scripture.

Message Discussion (50min)

1. TABLE TALK

• Think of a couple of highlights from a wedding you've attended (including your own); including the ceremony and reception (meal). What impressed or intrigued you? Share with the group.

2. ROYAL WEDDING

- **Read Revelation 19:6-10.** How would you describe the location and atmosphere of this "Table Talk"? What do you learn about Jesus? What do you learn about the guests?
- What was your favorite part of the wedding imagery in this sermon?
 Why do you think the Bible uses weddings to describe our relationship with Jesus?
 Have you ever thought of your faith as a Love Story before? Share and discuss why.
- Revelation 19:7

"Let us be glad and rejoice... for the time has come for the wedding feast of the Lamb."

What does it mean to rejoice in that context?

How does this future event affect your present outlook on life?

3. TO BE A BRIDE

• In ancient Jewish weddings, the groom would go prepare a place for the bride.

Jesus said the same in John 14:2-3.

How does it change your day-to-day perspective to know Jesus is preparing a place for you—right now?

- What does it look like to "prepare ourselves" as the Bride of Christ?

 (See Revelation 19:8 "the fine linen represents the good deeds of God's holy people.")
- What are some practical ways we can live like we're getting ready for the wedding?

4. THE LAMB OF GOD

- What does the name "<u>Lamb of God</u>" mean to you personally?
 How does seeing Jesus as the Lamb—who gave everything—change the way you relate to Him?
- The invitation to <u>The Marriage Supper of the Lamb</u> is extended to all—but must be accepted. Have you said "Yes" to Jesus? If so, what helped you take that step? What questions or doubts do you still have?
- The closing story was about a surprising guest who found their seat at the table.
 Who do you know that needs to hear they're invited to the Last, Last Supper?
 What could it look like to invite them into that hope this week?
 >> Remember them in our prayer time together.

Reflection & Prayer (15min)

REFLECTION

- 1 Peter 2:9
 - ...For you are a chosen people. You are royal priests, a holy nation, God's very own possession. As a result, you can show others the goodness of God, for he called you out of the darkness into his wonderful light.
- What does it mean for us to be royals and live as royalty in God's kingdom?
