Message: Part 3 - When You Are Persecuted

#### \*ICEBREAKERS:

- a. Sun. November 3 was our Missions Focus Sunday, and the International Day of Prayer for the Persecuted Church.
  - \*Did you check out the *Missions Expo* in the Conference Hall or chat with any of our Missionaries and Ministry Partners? *Share your feedback.*
- b. "...Send me Lord"
  - \*Have you ever served Christ in another country/culture as part of a short or long-term mission?
  - \*If you could go on a short-term Missions trip anywhere in the world which country/culture would you choose?
  - \*If you had to live & serve long-term (for years) in a foreign country which country/culture would you choose?

# **Sunday Message Discussion** (35-40min)

- 1. Invite one person read the Beatitudes in Matthew 5:1-12 and open in Prayer:
  - > We will read *The Beatitudes* each week during this series. We challenge you to memorize this passage.

    Option Choose a different reader and English translation/paraphrase each week. (NLT, ESV, NIV, NKJV, Message, TPT...)
- Message Feedback: Share your feedback on Kevin & Julia Garrett's story & message from Sunday.
  - a. What impacted, encouraged or challenged you the most and why?
  - b. Can you recall or describe the details of the persecution they faced and how they responded to it?
- Read <u>Matthew 5:10-12</u> God blesses those who are persecuted for Him.
  - **a. NOTE:** Jesus is addressing persecution for one's faith in Christ, which includes one's life practice (living righteously).
  - **b. 10 Forms of Persecution** Read & discuss as a group.

[listed by the Barnabas Fund, an international body formed to support persecuted Christians. In ascending order of ferocity]

- 1. Social discrimination, such as pressure on a Christian woman to convert to Islam if she marries a Muslim.
- 2. Institutional discrimination, such as difficulties obtaining building permits to construct or repair Christian churches.
- 3. Employment discrimination, such as bias against Copts in the Egyptian military and public sectors.
- **4. Legal discrimination**: denying Christians and other religious groups access to the courts, legal representation or action by police when they are attacked.
- **5. Suppression of Christian missionary activity**, as in Iran, where missionaries are routinely arrested and deported or incarcerated.
- **6. Suppression of conversion to Christianity**, usually through "blasphemy" or "apostasy" laws. Nearly half the countries in the world have laws that criminalize apostasy, blasphemy or defamation of religion.
- **7. Forced conversion from Christianity**, sometimes involving "reconversion" ceremonies where Christians are made to embrace the religion they left for Christ.
- 8. Suppression of corporate worship, as when authorities in China or Saudi Arabia raid house churches.
- 9. Violence against individuals, the most common and most lethal form of the global war on Christians.
- **10. Community oppression**, when entire churches or faith groups are attacked.

- c. Which of the 10 forms of persecution are you most familiar with and which one are you least familiar with?
- d. Which of the 10 forms of persecution are you most concerned about & why?

#### 4. Persecution in Canada

- a. When was last time it cost you something significant to follow Jesus? Share some examples as a group.
- **b.** How do you see persecution changing in Canada moving forward?

## 5. Blessed in Persecution - Preparing & Responding to Persecution

- a. Read Luke 6:22-23. What in the world does Jesus mean by being Blessed in the midst of persecution?
- **b. Word:** Share the reading of these examples of the many Scripture addressing Persecution: Matthew 5:44 & 10:22; John 15:20; 2 Timothy 3:10-13; 2 Corinthians 12:10; 1 Peter 4:12-14; Romans 8:35-39 & 12:12-14; Hebrews 10:23-25.
- **c.** How is the endurance, joy and hope of the Disciples and early Christians powerful evidence for the reality of Christ's Resurrection?
- d. Considering the examples and teachings of Jesus, the early Christians, and persecuted Christians today...
  - \*What are some ways that we can prepare and then respond to persecution? <u>Brainstorm & share as a group</u>. [e.g. Prayer, Know God's Word Better, Christian Community, Living with Integrity & Excellence, Loving our Enemies...]
    \*Why do you think it's worth it?

# **Application** (10min)

\*Consider: The last book in the Bible, <u>Revelation</u>, is often considered a favourite book of persecuted Christians. If you've read *The Book of Revelation*, why do you think it's so encouraging to persecuted Christians? >> Challenge – read (or <u>listen</u>) through *The Book of Revelation* this coming week – which takes about 90mins.

### \*Memorize Matthew 5:10 this week.

"Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." – Jesus.

\*Memorize The Beatitudes throughout this series -- Matthew 5:3-10

# Prayer (20min)

\*Based on our topic and discussion let's share our requests and Pray for one another, and the persecuted Church.
