2. PSALM 139 - A Song of Identity. Read Psalm 139

*This is one of the most famous and most quoted Psalms. Why do you think that is?

- **a.** What do you learn about God's *character, power and work* through this Psalm?

 Omnipotent (All-Powerful), Omniscient (All-Knowing), Omnipresent, Eternal, Love, Wisdom, Light, Holy, Creator, Provider, Saviour...
- **b.** What do you learn about us as humans?
 Wonderfully Created, Fragile, Loved, Fully-Known, Given Free Will, Sinful/Rebellious, In Need of a Saviour, Bestowed with Eternal Value
- c. What do you learn about yourself personally?
- **d.** Which verses stand out or impacts you the most in Psalm 139?

3. Fully Known & Loved by God – Far Too Wonderful

- **a.** When you deeply consider that God fully knows us, with nothing hidden & no place to hide... how does that make you feel or respond?
- **b.** When you deeply consider that God fully loves us along with His full knowledge of us... how does that make you feel or respond?
- c. Could/Should our response to God change in light of Psalm 139?

4. The Woman at the Well. Read John 4:1-42

- *This is one example of Jesus displaying His divine knowledge & love for someone who appears to be a complete stranger.
- a. How does the Samaritan Woman respond to Jesus' personal knowledge and love for her?
- **b.** What can we learn about Jesus from this story and from her response?
- c. How does Psalm 139 correspond with this story?
- d. Can you think of other examples/stories in the Bible that reflect Psalm 139 and this story?

5. Defining Identity

- *The Psalmist David clearly looks to God for Identity and finds it in Him.
- **a.** How is Psalm 139 about *Identity*?
 - why/how it's important, where we should look for it, and how God can provide it for us...
- b. How could God use the truths of Psalm 139 and John 4 provide and define your Identity for you?

- 6. Living with Open & Teachable Spirit towards God. Read Psalm 139:23-24
 - **a.** What do these lyrics of David's psalm teach and encourage us to apply to lives?
 - : Seek Instruction, Accountability and Leadership from God each day. Or be "FAT" Faithful, Available & Teachable.
 - **b.** What is one way that you can apply this in your life this week?

- *Challenge: Read & Pray through one Psalm each day in August.
