^{*&}quot;<u>Heaven</u>" in the Bible can refer to 3 things/places: a. the Atmosphere b. Outer Space c. God's Heaven/City

^{*}Metaphors for Heaven in Scripture: *like a Bride *a City

^{*}The word "Heaven" is found 276 times in the New Testament alone! <u>Heaven & Hell</u> are not specifically mentioned together in the same verses in Scripture, but <u>Heaven & Earth</u> are mentioned in the same verses over 200 times. Heaven & Earth were made together and they belong together, and God will ultimately reconcile Heaven & Earth.

5. HEAVEN is worth preparing for, hoping for, waiting for, and sharing with others!

God will have unbroken and unhindered fellowship with His people. They will complete clarity and intimacy. Enduring the Curse will be over! Jesus is the focus! He is the Light of Heaven. There is no time limit in Heaven (eternal). The best of life on Earth is just a taste of the feast in Heaven.

"The most tragic strain in human existence lies in the fact that the pleasure which we find in the things of this life, however good that pleasure may be in itself, is always taken away from us.
