- **Connect** (15min) share refreshments.
- 1. This Is Us...
  - a. What is one thing about your Family (currently or growing up) that we don't know about you yet?
- 2. March Focus: Split into groups of 3-4 (or men/women)
  - "LORD, Help Me...To develop a consistent daily devotional time with You." #2020 Prayer Goals
  - a. Share a highlight from your Devotions (reading/prayer) this past week, or your plan for the month of March.
  - b. Read <u>Revelation 7:9-10</u> & <u>Revelation 21:1-7</u>
    - > Invite the Group to give thanks & praise to God together as you begin your time of discussion & sharing.

# Sunday Message Discussion (35-40min)

\*Share the reading of the Scriptures throughout the discussion.

# 1. Potlucks & Restaurants

- a. Would you rather eat at a Potluck or a Restaurant?
- b. What is one of your favorite things to eat at a Potluck? What do you look for?
- c. What is one of your favorite restaurants (or kinds of restaurant) to eat at and why?
- d. Would you view The Church as more of a "Potluck" or "Restaurant" experience, and how so?

# 2. The Outsiders

Can you think of an experience in your life where you felt like you were an outsider? Describe & Discuss.

# 3. Great Expectations

a. When you come to church (on Sunday & to Life Group) do you come expecting something?

- **b.** What expectations do you think people have when they come to church from these 3 perspectives?
  - i. They have never been church before, and know very little about Christianity, the Bible or Church.
  - ii. They've had limited to some exposure to "Church..."
    - (perhaps through media, kids/youth events, summer camp, Christmas & Easter)
  - iii. They're familiar with the Christian faith and "Church..."

c. How are their expectations fair or not? Discuss.

# 4. One Father, One Family, One House & Many Rooms (& Siblings) -- Read John 14:2-3.

\* This week, we heard about the power of being part of God's family.

a. What is one word that would describe your family growing up? Why that word?

**b.** Pair up (with someone you are not related to) and share one strength and one weakness/challenge in your family experience so far.

c. We have all had different family experiences growing up, and perhaps with the family we are raising.

How is your experience or view of being part of God's family similar or different from the family you grew up in? **d.** Why do you think "Family" is such a common & important theme in God's Story throughout the Bible?

#### 5. Family Matters

\*Optional – Watch <u>The Bible Project – Overview of Ephesians</u>: <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Y71r-T98E2Q</u> (8min) \*Read <u>Ephesians 2:11-22</u>

- a. What is one thing you initially learn about God here, and what is one thing you initially learn about us?
- b. Do you recall where is Paul writing the letter to the Ephesians from?
- c. What is a Gentile? Would you be considered one?
  - If so, how does what Paul's message impact you personally? Discuss.
- **d.** Shawn referred to a story in <u>Acts 21-22</u> to give us some insight to what Paul is saying in Ephesians 2:11-22. Did this context help you understand what and why he wrote what he did? Discuss.
- e. In Ephesians 2:11-22 Paul worked hard at breaking down the wall of separation between the Gentile and Jewish believers.

**i. Read** <u>Colossians 3:11-17</u>. As you read/listen to this Scripture write down the characteristics & attitudes listed that can help build the kind of community that Paul wrote about to the Ephesians.

ii. Look at the list in Colossians 3:11-17.

If you had to grow in one area more than the others, which one would it be? Why?

- f. Paul wrote about breaking down "<u>walls of hostility</u>" (Eph.2:14). He pointed out that there are all kinds of walls that can hold us back from experiencing the kind of community that God wants us to have.
   \*What are some of the walls (actions & attitudes) that keep us from living as "*citizens*" of God? Discuss.
- **g.** How can focusing on **"what I can give"** rather than **"what can I get**" help bring down some of the dividing walls you just a talked about?
- **h.** Are there any insights from <u>Colossians 3:11-17</u> that if followed or applied would move a person to becoming more of a 'giver' than a 'taker?' Discuss.

#### 6. The Power of Family Promises

One of the significant benefits of being part of God's Family is that you can experience God's presence & promises now and throughout eternity. Below, are four of the many promises God gives us in his Word.

\*Which one catches your attention the most and why?

a. <u>1 Peter 5:6-7</u> – God's Care b. <u>2 Corinthians 1:3-4</u> - God's Comfort

#### c. <u>Isaiah 40:31</u> – God's Strength & Endurance d. <u>Psalm 139:5</u> – God's Presence & Blessing

- 1. What is ONE THING from Sunday's Message to remember & apply in your life this week?
- 2. PRAY for ONE ANOTHER: \*Seek Out Opportunities to Pray for and with the People around me. #2020 Prayer Goals
