Sunday Message Feedback :: Creation & Science...

*Scripture References: a few of the many...that speak about Creator God & His Creation.

In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. Genesis 1:1

Great are the works of the Lord, studied by all who delight in them. Psalm 111:2

Where were you when I laid the foundation of the earth? Tell me if you have understanding. Job 38:4 But ask the beasts, and they will teach you; the birds of the heavens, and they will tell you; or the bushes of the earth, and they will teach you; and the fish of the sea will declare to you. Who among all these does not know that the hand of the LORD has done this? Job 12:7-9

For by Him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities – all things were created through Him and for Him. And He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together. Colossians 1:16-17

For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse. Romans 1:20

2. Christians, in regards to Creation, can agree on the fact that the Bible declares...

WHO Created – God/Jesus (the Word)

WHEN – In the beginning (even though there are different ideas about the date/age) : the earth has a beginning, a cause, and must have a Maker who caused it. : even the *Big Bang theory* points to a starting point with a *Cause*.

WHAT – the heavens & the earth..., human beings in the image of God...

<u>WHY</u> – for God's glory & pleasure, and for humans to have a holy relationship with Him and each other...and for humanity to steward the earth.

<u>HOW</u> – by His WORD (spoken), out of nothing, with order & purpose... *but we don't know <u>all the details of how it happened</u> (scientifically...)

*Remember – all worldviews need to be able to respond to the same questions...
