- 3. OPEN UP I Read <u>2 Corinthians 5:16-21</u>. Respond with Praise to God & Prayer for One Another.

## Message Discussion (45min)

#### 1. GOD & GOVERNMENT

**a.** Do you tend to avoid conversation around *religion and politics*, or do you enjoy conversations on *religion and politics*? Discuss.

**b.** If you had to be a politician in Canada would you prefer to serve in *Municipal (Local), Provincial or Federal* politics? Which role in that political arena would interest or suit you the most?

**c.** What did you learn from Sunday's Message? What encouraged, challenged or surprised you? Did it cause you to evaluate your posture and thoughts towards government? Discuss.

#### 2. AUTHORITY

- a. Do you prefer to be under someone's authority or have authority over someone, and why?
- **b.** Have you ever read or heard something from the Bible you don't like or agree with? How did you navigate your thoughts and feelings about that information? Discuss.

#### c. 🛄 Read <u>Romans 12:1-2, 14-21</u>

What do these verses teach us about how we should live and think?

#### d. 🛄 Read Romans 13:1-7

- i. What is your knee-jerk response to these verses?
- ii. Have you ever viewed the government through the filter of these verses? Why/why not?
- **iii.** Do you think our Gospel witness would be strengthened if we saw the government the way Paul tells us to?
- iv. How can a wrong view of government hurt our witness for Christ? Discuss.

#### 3. CITIZENS & AMBASSADORS

\*Shawn gave some perspective to the government of the day. He mentioned that Paul wrote these words as a crazy dictator named <u>Nero</u> was burning Christians to light up his gardens.

- a. With that information how do Pauls words impact you and our current struggles with government?
- **b.** *Romans* compels us to submit even to the most wicked leaders...
  - Why would God want us to do such a thing?
- **c.** How does the sovereignty of God impact your view and posture towards government? Does it bring you peace? Does it help you trust God more? Discuss.

**d.** Why is biblical submission to authority not only mandatory but also essential for us as followers of Jesus? Consider these Scriptures to help navigate this question – <u>Hebrews 10:32-36</u>, James 1:2-4, Romans 5:1-5.

**e.** Can you think of any significant character-building lessons you have learned in the past when having to deal with a difficult authority figure?

f. Shawn talked about whether there is ever a time for civil disobedience.

Do you remember the principles he shared? What are you thoughts on these principles?

- i. If the law is just obey it!
- ii. If the law is stupid obey it or willingly accept the consequences (ie speeding)
- iii. If the law is sinful disobey it and willingly accept the consequences.
