1. What is 1 way that our COMMUNITY has helped your faith journey this past year? (in Serving, in Life Group, in Accountability, through Care, in Prayer/Spiritual Warfare...)

#### 2. READ Philippians 2:25-30 & 4:18-20

: Have you ever met someone with the *name* Epaphroditus?

: His name means 'Handsome & Charming'.

- Who is the most 'handsome & charming' man you know? just kidding.

: If you were under House-Arrest (in Prison for your Faith), what would you hope to receive in a Care Package from a church in another country? (Have each person in your group choose a different item)

: How did Epaphroditus model/put-into-practice what Paul instructs us to do in Philippians 2:1-18?

: Do you know anyone *like* Epaphroditus? How are they like him?

- PAUL refers to Epaphroditus as his <u>True Brother</u>, <u>Co-Worker</u>, & <u>Fellow Soldier</u>. (He recognized the value & need for all three roles and responsibilities in him, and the church)
  - 1. <u>BROTHERS & SISTERS</u> = COMMUNITY (Common Family, Father & Love)
  - 2. <u>CO-WORKER</u> = CORPORATION/COOPERATION (Common Work)
  - 3. FELLOW SOLDIER = CAUSE (Common Battle & Victory)
  - :: Why are ALL 3 important in the Church today?
  - :: How would you rank these 3 ways to Invest in Community for yourself?

  : Where & How are you/we working to advance the work of Jesus Christ? (Locally/Globally) (Philippians 2:12-18)
- 6. How can we grow in & experience the JOY of being "Fellow Soldiers" in Christ?
  : How can we enforce the Victory of Christ in our lives, families and community?
  : How can we *fight* together effectively in the spiritual realm (like a Roman unit)?
  (Ephesians 6:10-20)

  - : a Brother/Sister in Christ who loves you and has inspired/encouraged your faith...
