2. An Issue of Authority & An Issue with Authority

a. <u>Do you prefer</u> to be in charge or to let others be in charge? Share a few pros & cons with each position.

b. What are some of the options for Authority in our world & universe? Who's in Charge, and does it matter? Do you believe that there is a sovereign supreme being (God) in charge of the universe,

or is it simply random chance, the law of the jungle, survival of the fittest...?

c. What are some common issues that people have with authority, and even God's Authority?

3. CHRIST'S Claim on Authority

Matt. 28:18; John 6:35; John 8:12; John 8:58; John 10:7; John 10:30-33; John 11:25; John 14:6; John 15:5; Rev.1:8, 17-18 a. Can you recall some of the prophecies that Jesus fulfilled, and things He said and did that affirm His claim & identity as the Messiah (Savior King/God)?

b. Based on what we've just read and shared, what should our response to JESUS be?

4. Game of Thrones: Read John 18:28-40 – Jesus' Trial Before Pilate.

*One of the primary reasons why Jesus was arrested and crucified is He claimed to be God (which threatened the Jews) and King (which threatened the Romans).

a. How does JESUS' presence, power and authority challenge the *"Truths & Thrones"* of our lives and culture?
b. So, who's in charge of your life? What does mean for you and I personally -- to acknowledge, embrace and follow JESUS CHRIST as God & King? What are the challenges, benefits & responsibilities?
