- 1. OPEN Invite 1 Person to Read 2 Peter 3:18 & Open your discussion in Prayer.

- 2. NOT ALL SEQUELS ARE EQUAL: What is your favorite Movie Sequel? What is the worst Movie Sequel? How do the Movies typically depict Peter (his look & personality)?
- 3. 2 MINUTE DRILL PETER: As a Group State as many facts/details about PETER as you can in 2 mins.

 Simon the Son of John / Cephas (Aramaic) & Petros (Greek) = "The ROCK".

 Fisherman Disciple Apostle Martyr. From Bethsaida, Galilee & Capernaum.

From what you know about the Disciple Peter do you see a change/difference in him from when Jesus first called him to this point where he is writing 2nd Peter and is close to death? What kind of changes can you see in his life? How has he spiritually grown?

- 4. LETTER WRITING has become a lost form of communication, even though we may use email nowadays.
 - *When is the last time you wrote or received a personal Letter in the mail?
- 5. READ RE:PETE
 - <u>2 PETER</u> was a Letter written to early Christians. It would initially have been read as an entire letter.
 - a. (Optional) WATCH The Bible Project Introduction to 2 Peter on YouTube (8min)
 - **b. SHARE the READING of 2 Peter** as a Group (approx. 10-12mins) to get the full scope of Peter's Letter.

6. RE:PETE Reaction

a. What is your initial reaction to Peter's intense & loving Letter to Christ-Followers?

A key theme of 2nd Peter is to prepare believers to stand firm in their faith and to live in the hope of Jesus return. While we wait for Jesus to come back Peter encourages his readers to be productive and fruitful with their lives and to not give up.

- b. When was the last time you thought about JESUS coming back one day? Discuss.
- c. Why do you think we don't think much about Christ's Return?

7. Spiritual Growth – Training with *The ROCK*

- *Peter experienced a process of transformation & spiritual growth through his relationship with Jesus.
- a. Why is spiritual growth important to having a faith that is strong and lasting? Discuss.
- **b.** Why do you think God designed spiritual growth to be a journey? Discuss.
- c. Do you ever get frustrated in your journey of spiritual growth? Why?
- **d.** How might the following verses encourage one who's frustrated with their spiritual growth process?
