 - 1. How would you describe or define **INTEGRITY** (Moral Excellence)?

2. READ Psalm 15:1-5

- a. How does this passage of Scripture paint a picture of what a life of integrity looks like?
- 3. How have you experienced the benefits of integrity in your life? Share. Have others benefited from your integrity?

Moral Excellence can be defined as your behavior matching your beliefs.

Describe a time when your behavior matched your beliefs? Discuss.

4. READ Matthew 23:23-32

- a. The opposite of moral excellence or integrity -- is hypocrisy.
 - *How does Jesus deal with the hypocrites in this passage?
- **b.** Would you ever consider yourself a hypocrite? Discuss. How have you/we addressed our own hypocrisy in the past?
- **c.** Why is it important to avoid being a hypocrite? What are some consequences of hypocrisy?
- 5. **READ Job 27:5-6** and **Matthew 5:37** (these verses encourage us to maintain our integrity)

 - **d.** How much is your integrity worth to you?
 - **e.** How does living with moral excellence mature you in your faith and get you more rooted in Christ? Discuss.
 - **f.** What can you do on a daily basis to develop the forgotten virtue of integrity? eg. Philippians 4:8
