Connect (30min)

*If this is your first meeting of the fall season, we recommend using the *Connect* segments from the past two guides.

*For Connect and Prayer, you may want to break into two groups, or groups of 3-4 people to enhance participation.

1. High-Low-Taco

Briefly share 1 Highlight, 1 Low (Challenge) and 1 Random Fact (Interesting, weird, funny) from you past week.

2. Monthly Health Check: Every month we will give opportunity for a personal health check-in.

Using a scale of 1-10 (Poor-Excellent) how is your a. Physical Health b. Mental Health c. Spiritual Health?

Message Discussion (45min)

1. Canvas of Creation

Creation is the canvas on which God has painted His character. – Unknown

- Read Romans 1:20 and then answer these three questions in groups of 2-3 people.
- a. Why does an artist create anything?
- **b.** Think of 5 of your Favorite Things about God's Creation and share together.
- c. What have your learned about God's character from Creation?

2. The Grand Story - CREATION

a. Share your initial feedback on Sunday's Message.

What connected with you, encouraged you, challenged you, or confused you? What did you learn? Which wonders and questions did it leave you with?

 Read Genesis 1 as a group.
 - { Optional Video: <u>Genesis 1- The Bible Project</u> (5min)}
 - i. Using just 1 or 2 words what is your initial reaction/response to this story?
- - i. What do you learn about God here?
 - ii. What do you learn about humanity? Who are we made like? What purpose and job are we given by God?

3. Our Story

- - i. What do you learn about God here? ii. What do you learn about yourself (and others)?
 - ii. Why did God create you, and what did He create you for?
- **b.** God created us as human beings, but we often live as human doings.
 - i. What happens to us when we live as human doings? Discuss
 - ii. What happens with our relationship with God and others when we focus on living as human beings?

- **4.** "In the beginning, God created..." establishes that God wrote The Grand Story, giving us insight (revelation) into who He is.
 - a. Do you remember the three attributes Shawn shared about God?{God is *powerful* (sovereign), *wise* (all knowing) and *good* (loving)}
 - **b.** Why is it important for us to understand these attributes of God to understand *The Grand Story* of Scripture properly? How would the story be different if God wasn't these things? Discuss.

5. Engage The Story

- a. What is one way that you can engage and celebrate your Creator through His Creation this week?
- **b.** Believing that God created us first for relationship with Him through faith, why do we need to continue to read His Word and believe Him daily? How does this empower our spiritual growth?

Prayer (15min)

*Share and pray as a large group or break into smaller groups (Men/Women or groups of 3-4).

P.R.A.Y.

- Read: Psalm 8. Have one of the group members read this psalm for the group.
- >> In response to the discussion and scripture how can we pray for you (personally)?

God's Power - Provision - Protection - Presence - Peace

- Pray: Take 10min to P.R.A.Y. together. Time & transition to each component.
- -- Pause (be still & listen. 2min) -- Rejoice & Reflect (praise & thanks. 2min)
- -- Ask (invite & request. 4min) -- Yes (surrender & trust. 2min)
