Welcome & Prayer

Read John 14:1-7

PRAY *JESUS – You are the King of Kings and Lord of Lords. You are Creator, Savior, Beginning & End.

- **1.** a. **Describe the first funeral you ever attended. What memories do you have?** How did it effect you.
 - b. What is one thing that you want to do in life before you die? (i.e., what is on your bucket list?)
 - c. Why do you think people are reluctant to talk about death?
 - d. How could that reluctance affect the way we live? Discuss.
- 2. When you were a Child (under 12), what did you think Heaven is like? Has your belief in & understanding of Heaven changed since then, and if so, what is 1 example of how it's changed?
- Shawn introduced the message by saying that most people do believe in heaven.
 <u>What is hard to believe is the belief that not everyone will go there</u>!
 *Do you find that true in your experience with people? Discuss.
- 4. Read Matthew 7:13. What do these words of Jesus tell us about heaven? Discuss.

- 5. Shawn talked about a number of different beliefs that people have regarding the afterlife. Which one(s) have you heard people use or have used yourself:
 - a. 'As long as we are sincere then any spiritual path works.' 'There are many ways to Heaven'
 'Only ignorant people think Jesus is the only way to heaven'
 (instead, check out John 14:6)
 - b. 'A God of love would never send anyone to hell.'
 'Lots of good deeds can balance out a few bad deeds!' 'I can get to Heaven on my own terms/merit' (instead, read Mt.7:13-14; Mt.25:46; Rom.6:23; Ephesians 2:8-9; Luke 12:5; Heb.9:27)
 - c. Other Myths about Heaven:
 - : 'We become Angels' (instead, read Psalm 8:4-8; 1 Corinthians 15; Revelation)
 - : 'We have to get through Peter at the Gates of Heaven' (instead, read Rev.20:12)
 - : 'Heaven is going to be boring' (instead, read Isaiah 65:17-25; Revelation 19 & 21)
- 6. Do you agree with this statement, "<u>Heaven is FOR us but not ABOUT us</u>." Discuss.
 Read Isaiah 65:17-25 (or Rev.21:1-4); Corinthians 4:17-18 & 1Thessalonians 4:13-18
 What do you imagine heaven will be like? Discuss

7. Read 2 Corinthians 5:1-10

- a. What can Christians look forward to? (5:1)
- **b.** Why did Paul long for heaven? (5:2-3)
- c. For what purpose has God made us? (5:4-5)
- d. What is true as long as we are alive on this earth? (5:6)
- e. How is the Christian life lived? (5:7)
- f. What should be all Christians goal? (5:9)
- g. Who will be judged by Jesus? (5:10)
- h. What will people receive at the judgement seat of Christ? (5:10)

8. Read Matthew 6:19-21

a. What is Jesus teaching us about Heaven in these verses? Discuss.

9. If someone asked you:

"Do you believe in Heaven, and how do you know that you'll be there one day?"

- how would you answer?
- **10.** Do you think that JESUS wants us to have clarity, a growing understanding, a vibrant passion, and a deep assurance about our relationship with Him and Heaven?

Do you personally feel ready/confident/assured about your eternal destiny?

*If yes, how so? *If not, would you like to be? *How can we encourage you?

Application

<u>Why</u> is it important to have a Biblical understanding and passion for Heaven? <u>What</u> difference should the truth and hope Heaven make in our daily lives? <u>How</u> can you live more intentionally with the Hope of Heaven in your life? Share examples...
