#### **Open in Prayer Together**

### Sunday Message Discussion (35-40min)

- Invite one person read the Beatitudes in <u>Matthew 5:1-12</u> & another person to open in Prayer:

   a. Has anyone memorized this passage (even verses 3-10) through the series? Share with the group.
   b. Which of the 8 Beatitudes has impacted you the most this series, and how?
- Read <u>Matthew 5:9</u> -- God blesses those who work for peace, for they will be called the children of God.. The BIG IDEA: A Peacemaker faces conflict with grace & truth. Message Feedback: Share your initial feedback on Sunday's Message. \*What impacted you the most and why?

#### 3. Peacemaker or Troublemaker?

- **a.** Would others have considered you a peacemaker or a troublemaker while you were growing up? Has this changed over the years, and how?
- **b.** Can you think of any *Troublemakers* who became *Peacemakers*? (In the Bible or in your life experience)

c. Where do you tend to find peace in your life?

#### 4. Shalom – "Peace"

a. (Optional) Watch <u>The Bible Project Word Study: Shalom – "Peace"</u> on YouTube. (3min)
b. When you think of the Words Peace and Peacemaker what comes to mind?

c. Is there a difference between a PEACEMAKER & a PEACEKEEPER?

#### 5. Read Matthew 18:15-17 – Jesus teaches on dealing with conflict.

a. Have you ever followed this advice from Jesus when it comes to conflict and unrest in your relationships?b. What do you think would be the result in your life if you followed His instructions from this passage of Scripture?

#### 6. The Prince of Peace & His Peacemakers

\*Read Isaiah 9:6 – What does it mean that The Messiah (Jesus) is the Prince of Peace?

- a. What is so profound about that title and role for JESUS? How does this impact our identity as His disciples?
- b. What does Jesus say is the blessing for being a peace maker? Does this sound strange to you?

c. What do you think it means to be "called children of God."?

**d.** Shawn talked about the idea that if you are not seeking to be a peacemaker then you do not look like your Father in heaven. How is this true?

#### 7. Read Ephesians 2:13-18

- a. How does the blood of Jesus impact how we become peacemakers? Why is it so important? Discuss.
- b. Read Romans 14:19 & 1 Peter 3:11 How is Peacemaking a proactive choice and responsibility?

### Application (5min)

God has blessed us with His peace and wants us to be present to it. He wants us to carry His peace to others, especially in this chaotic world.

1. What is one commitment that this group can make together to carry God's peace to others this week?

2. Read John 16:33
