Connect (10min)

Use the Lord's Prayer [Matthew 6:9-13] to Open in Prayer

Sunday Message Feedback (35-45min)

1. Dressed for Battle

If you had to time-travel and fight with the armor/uniform/weapons of any era of soldier/warfare, which would you choose and why?

Eg: Ancient (Egyptian, Greek, Roman, Barbarian), Medieval, Gunpowder Wafare, Industrial Warfare, or Modern Warfare

2. What impacted you from Sunday's message by Pastor Shawn?

: What challenged or encouraged you, and why? : What can you apply to your faith & life this week? How?

3. Life is a Battlefield -- Read Ephesians 6:10-18

"We are locked in a battle. This is not a friendly, gentlemen's discussion. It is a life and death conflict between the spiritual hosts of wickedness and those who claim the name of Christ." - Francis A. Schaeffer

"Spiritual warfare is very real. There is a furious, fierce, and ferocious battle raging in the realm of the spirit between the forces of God and the forces of evil. Warfare happens every day, all the time. Whether you believe it or not, you are in a battlefield. You are in warfare." – Pedro Okoro

"There is no neutral ground in the universe; every square inch, every split second is claimed by God and counterclaimed by Satan." – C.S. Lewis

"The nature of the enemy's warfare in your life is to cause you to become discouraged and to cast away your confidence. Not that you would necessarily discard your salvation, but you could give up your hope of God's deliverance. The enemy wants to numb you into a coping kind of Christianity that has given up hope of seeing God's resurrection power." – Bob Sorge

Discuss the Impact & Application of the following <u>3 Keys</u> from Sunday's Message:

- a. We don't avoid the Battle we stand firm in them.
- b. If I don't know I'm in a Battle or have an enemy, I've already lost.
- c. I need to Know my Commander and who I fight with and for.

4. Armed & Equipped

Note: The Apostle Paul's reference point for the Armor & Warfare Strategy was the Roman Soldier. **a. Based on what you know about Roman soldiers/armies -- how/why were they so effective?**

[eg. they were well trained & equipped, disciplined, & they fought effectively as a unit (offense & defense)]

> How can we translate this into the Spiritual application used by Paul? (Refer to the photo/chart on p.3&4)

- > How do you think the original audience of Christians received and applied Paul's metaphor/message?
- 5. Modern Warfare: If Paul were writing this passage of Scripture today how may the armor look different? Instead of a Roman soldier what would he use to describe the armor in today's culture?

b. Which piece of God's Armor do you understand and engage with the most, and why?
c. Paul tells us that we must put on "*every piece of armor*" (v.13), why is this important for spiritual victory? What happens when we fail to wear it all? Why would someone not wear it all?
d. <u>Discuss</u> how we are instructed to engage once we have the Armor on? (v.18)

6. Worth Fighting For:

Shawn said that "we change how we fight when we have something worth fighting for." Has your understanding of spiritual warfare changed over the years? Has your desire to fight for God's Kingdom become more passionate in your life? Why or why not?

Share the Reading of Romans 13:11-14; 2 Corinthians 10:3-5; 2 Timothy 2:3-4; Romans 8:35-39
