Sunday Message Feedback (35min)

* Pastor Shawn continues our LIFE 101 series in 1 Peter.

1. IDENTITY:

a. What are some common ways/sources through which people try to find or define their Identity in life? (family, friends, credentials, work, talents, awards/titles, fame, clothing, possessions, pleasure, religion...)
b. Why do you think 'Identity' so important to us as Humans?

- 2. Without referring to Sunday's message how have you traditionally perceived God's thoughts about you? In other words in the past what words would you use to describe how you thought God sees you?
- 3. Did Sunday's message change your perceptions of how God sees you? Why/why not? Read <u>1 Peter 2:4-10</u>
 Why/why is a second of Cariature 2

What jumps out at you from this passage of Scripture?

- 4. We heard this weekend how followers of Jesus have now become priests and Jesus has taken over the role of the high priest. Because he is in that role, things have changed dramatically for us. How do the following passages about Christ being our High Priest encourage you in your walk with him?
 - a. <u>Hebrews 4:14-16</u>
 - b. <u>Hebrews 7:23-28</u>

5. Do you typically feel you have full access to God? Why/why not?

Have you ever believed or felt that you had to go through another human to access God? (ie. family member, saint, priest, pastor, leader) If so, how has this changed for you?

- 6. Do you ever have a hard time believing that Jesus understands the difficulties you face in life? If so, explain.
- 7. One of the primary responsibilities of the Old Testament priests was to offer the various sacrifices required by the law. While these sacrifices are no longer applicable today, there are still sacrifices that Christians are called to make. What do you find challenging about making the sacrifices found in the passages below?
 - a. <u>Romans 12:1-2</u> *Living Sacrifice* (with our bodies & minds ie. purity)
 - b. Philippians 4:14-19 Sacrifice of Giving/Generosity
 - c. <u>Hebrews 13:14-15</u> Sacrifice of Praise
- 8. Have you ever had an experience where you were able to focus on the benefits of any of the actions mentioned in these scriptures, rather than on what you were giving up?
- 9. Can you think of any other actions that could also be considered sacrifices we could make to God?
- 10. Shawn mentioned that we are "God's possession."

The King James Version translates this term as "*A peculiar people.*" We are God's peculiar people which means people are going to see us as strange or even weird at times – specifically in how we act and respond to those around us.

- a. What are some ways that our actions should be seen as peculiar to those around us?
- **b.** Can you think of a situation in your life where because of your peculiar response someone was drawn to Jesus, or at least wondered what was different about you? Share.

Application & Prayer (20min)

"Remember Whose you are and Whom you serve" - Oswald Chambers.

Read <u>1 Peter 2:9-10</u> – You are <u>Chosen, a Royal Priest, a Holy Person & God's Possession</u>

• Which truth about how God sees you do you struggle with the most (that you are a chosen person, a royal priest, a holy person or God's possession)

Read Jude 1:1 – You are <u>Called, Loved & Kept</u>!

• **<u>Pray</u>** for one another and ask Jesus to help you see yourself as God sees you.
