Founded in 1969 by Ilonna Pederson, Director of the NYK, the group has toured extensively throughout the world, including annual tours within the state of North Dakota. Ilonna Pederson is a native North Dakotan who through research has produced a repertoire of music that ranges from early music of the Renaissance through Contemporary compositions, incorporating a casual presentation that allows the audience to know more about the works performed and the instruments used.

William Wielgus has been a member of the New York Kammermusiker (NYK) since 2017. He is representing the NYK this month to honor fellow oboist Jeffrey Hale. Jeff was a member of the NYK for 38 years of its 53 year history, traveling around the world and to North Dakota for the annual tours. Bill continues the vision of NYK in performing music from different eras and from different cultures. Mr. Wielgus will be joined by the organist of First Presbyterian Church, Sally Harmon.

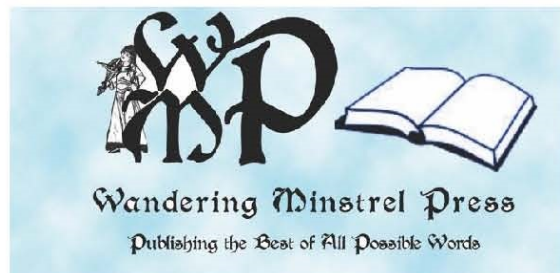
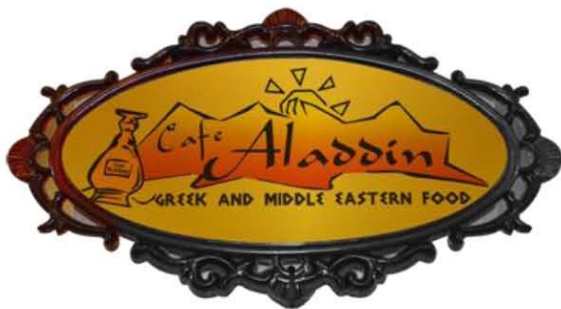
