KEY PASSAGE:

“Surely He took up our pain and bore our suffering, yet we considered Him punished by God, stricken by Him and afflicted. But He was pierced for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on Him, and by His wounds we are healed.



Isaiah 41:10


What can I praise the Lord for in my life?

Who's kingdom is the "kingdom that cannot be shaken"?

Note: The "kingdom that cannot be shaken" is a kingdom that can go through anything and still be standing.

What does it mean to "receive a kingdom that cannot be shaken"?

Note: We are part of God's Kingdom when we accept Jesus as our Savior.

What are two things that we should do to glorify God?

Note: "Reverence" means to have respect for and "awe" means to have respect mixed with amazement.

How does verse 29 describe God?

Note: A small flame can be distinguished, but a roaring fire cannot be put out easily and is often not controlled. We cannot control God and He is to be respected.



What does it mean to me that God’s kingdom will always win, no matter what?



1 John 1:9




Is there someone that I could become a prayer partner with?



Once we ask Jesus to forgive us, He takes away all of our sins. Jesus saves us from the penalty for our sins. And when we trust

Jesus as our Savior, we become part of God's family forever

(1 John 5:11-12). Because we are part of God's family, we should

live in a way that pleases Him and do things that help us learn more about Him (Colossians 1:10).

Jesus didn't stay dead.

The Bible tells us that He rose from the dead and lives today. That means we can talk to Him right now. If we believe that Jesus died on the cross to take the

consequences for our sins and rose from the dead (Romans 10:9-10), we can ask

God to forgive us, and He will (Colossians 1:13-14).

Jesus is God's perfect Son. Jesus died on a cross to take the consequences for our sins (John 3:16). Because Jesus died for us, God

forgives our sins.




