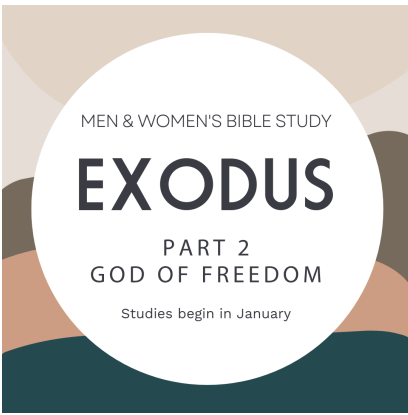
Sunday Morning Classes
